Born in Ningxiang, Hunan, Liu Yin (Qing Dynasty) enjoyed painting and writing calligraphy, as well as playing music and reciting poetry. He was close friends with Hu Dayuan (1778-1841), Peng Jun (1769-1833), Shi Cheng and Deng Xianhe (1777-1851). Liu Yin was once invited to the Ruyi Hall to paint for the Imperial Palace and *Eight Sights of Xiao Xiang* was one of his most well-known works during his time there. He later traveled around the province of Hunan, frequently painting landscape series.



Zhao Shigang (1874-1945) was a painter, calligrapher, educator, and scholar of the classics from Zhejiang province during the late Qing-early Republic period. After the Republic of China was established, Zhao moved to Shanghai and lived as a recluse.

Ni Zan (1301–1374) was born into a wealthy family in Wuxi prefecture. Around the age of 53, he left his homeland in order to avoid war and harsh taxation. As he left his home to a life of travels, his painting style underwent a major evolution as he painted lonely landscapes that were representative of his desolate life at the time.

Although Landscape-A Gift to Ban Yun is a relatively small composition in the artist's repertoire, the work contains many elements of Ni Zan's masterpieces of the period. The structure of the distant mountains are reminiscent of his work, Fishing Village in an Autumn Clear Day, painted at the age of 55 and now located in the Shanghai Museum. The trees in the foreground are similar to those in Jiang'an Mountains, painted at the age of 60. The shape of the slender bamboo, with its branches and leaves, take the shape of those in Bamboo and Rocks, both of which belonged to the imperial collection and are now in the National Palace Museum in Taipei.

On the lower right-hand corner of Landscape-A Gift to Ban Yun are collectors' seals of the noted connoisseurs Dong Qichang (1555-1636) and Zhu Wenjun (1882-1937).

倪瓚(1301-1374)字元鎭,別號雲林子,出生於無錫富豪家 族,在五十三歲前後因避戰禍與苛稅而棄置家園,把田宅 變賣,餘生浪跡江湖,畫風由此而大變,晚年山水一片滄 茫落寞之景,是他蕭條心態的映照。按《淸閭閣全集》卷 十一,在漂泊期間,「元鎭好僧寺,一住必旬日,篝燈木 榻,蕭然晏坐,時操紙筆作竹石小景,客求必與,一時好 事者購之,價至數十金」,本圖作於六十一歲,題云:「至 正辛丑(1361)冬十一月邂逅畔雲隱君於華麓書院,因寫 以贈。倪瓚」,可知畔雲爲萍水相逢之交,爲作小景相贈, 正如書中記載。落款下不鈐印是倪畫常習,董其昌有記: 「雲林生平不畫人物…亦罕用圖書」(見《畫禪室隨筆》 卷二)。

《贈畔雲》雖爲小幅,其中蘊含了倪瓚一些同期名作的元 素,遠山結構與五十五歲《漁莊秋霽圖》頗相似(見《上 海博物館藏品精華》,前景樹木則接近六十三歲《江岸望 山圖》,細竹枝葉形態又如《筠石古槎圖》(以上二圖皆 清宮舊藏, 刋錄於《臺北故宮藏畫大系》冊三), 但兩幅 山水名跡高約一米,是遊歷訪友(王雲浦,陳惟允)時相 贈的用心作品,《贈畔雲》小幅高僅30公分,尺幅和用筆 不同,當不能單以畫冊按圖索驥,還須尋求有實際經驗的 專家意見。但兩幅山水名跡高約一米,是遊歷訪友(王雲 浦,陳惟允)時相贈的用心作品,《贈畔雲》畫心右下角 有收藏印章二方:「董其昌印」(朱白文),「翼盦審定」(朱文)。董氏生平過手名跡無數,對此小品未見有題識著 錄。翼盦即民國早期著名鑑賞家朱文鈞(1882-1937),為南宋理學家朱熹的廿四世孫,1925年故宮博物 院成立之初即受聘為專門委員,負責鑒定書書碑帖,1934 年國家文物首次出國在倫敦舉行大規模〈中國藝術展覽〉 ,其中書畫展品全由其選定,惜去世較早,著作在戰亂 後多已不存,所以近人對其成就認識不多,惟其子朱家濟 (1902-1969)、家溍(1914-2003)承傳家學,先後加入故 宫參與文物研究工作,皆任國家文物鑒定委員會委員 被 廣尊為國寶級鑑定大師。

朱氏藏品大部份在1953-1994年間分批捐贈國家,事成後 朱家溍先生始由翼盦原稿整理家藏目錄,於《收藏家》雜 誌分類發表,前後歷時五載,2014年故宮出版社復彙集刊 行《蕭山朱氏舊藏目錄》,頁四七錄正院西廂房櫃內貯《 倪雲林畫山水小景軸》,下註「掛屏、改裱」,即此《贈醉 雲小景》,今仍保持掛屏裝裱。作爲國家首席鑑定師,翼 盦先生當不會輕率鈐一「審定」印,必曾與其他倪畫原作 比對才作出判斷,他當年掌管故宮藏品,不賴畫册圖片, 所有清宮舊藏都有原作可參考,包括上述《江岸望山圖》 與《筠石古槎圖》在內。他把原置櫃中小軸改裝爲掛屏, 得以常懸壁上相對,其鍾愛可以想見。

在《目錄》出版後,收藏界對入錄藏品日益關注,近有清 人《畫林集粹》二冊及王鑑《擬古山水冊》出現於拍賣市 場,前者鈐「翼盦」印,後者鈐「翼盦珍秘」,由用印可識 别評價。《贈畔雲小景》鈐「翼盦審定」印,可謂一錘定 音,彌足珍貴。





This collection was assembled by Dr. Chen Ji (1896-circa 1982), who was a professor of pediatrics at St. John's School of Medicine in Shanghai. Dr. Chen brought the collection to the United States in 1965. His son, Chen Lien-ching (1922-2016), who was an architect who immigrated to the U.S. around 1945. Both father and son appreciated classical paintings and calligraphy, and also befriended contemporary artists, whose work they enjoyed and collected.





This collection of Chinese modern paintings was assembled by Yan Yuntai (Anthony Yen) and his father Yan Qingxiang (1899-1988). The elder Mr. Yan was a successful owner and manager of Da Long Steel and Iron Works in Shanghai before 1949. During and after the Cultural Revolution, Mr. Yan took up his attention to the arts. He took up calligraphy and traditional painting, and through the teachers he sought out, he developed relationships with an extended circle of painters and calligraphers. Recognizing the difficult circumstances that most of these artists experienced in the 1950s and 1960s, Mr Yan created a "salon" to welcome these talented individuals. They recited poetry in the garden, exchanged ideas, and hung their work in the living room, dining room, and center hall of the Yan family home at 699 Yu Yuan Road.

Anthony Yen left Shanghai alone in 1949 at the young age of 17 and made his way to the United States. There he built a distinguished career as an expert in international business and trade. Sharing his father's dedication to China's traditional arts, Mr. Yen also acquired and treasured paintings from the artists he met during his visits back to China beginning in 1980.



Zou Xing, also known as Shouyong, was a businesswoman and among the first to engage in trade between the US and China when exchange was reestablished in the 1970s. She was the daughter of Zou Lu (1885-1954), a founding father of modern China and Chancellor of Sun Yatsen University in Guangdong. Born in Guangzhou in the 1920s, she immigrated to the U.S. to attend university. During the span of her career, she lived and worked in the U.S. and in China. She was acquainted with many prominent artists, calligraphers and statesmen in New York, Taiwan, Hong Kong, and China. Her collection has remained within the family.

CONDITIONS OF SALE

These Conditions of Sale and the Important Notices and Explanation of Cataloguing Practice set out the terms on which we offer the **lots** insted in this catalogue for sale. By registering to bid and/or by bidding at auction you agree to these terms, so you should read them carefully before doing so. You will find a glossary at the end explaining the meaning of the words and expressions coloured in **bold**.

Unless we own a **lot** in whole or in part (Δ symbol), Christie's acts as agent for the seller.

A BEFORE THE SALE 1 DESCRIPTION OF LOTS

- (a) Certain words used in the catalogue description have special meanings. You can find details of these on the page headed "Important Notices and Explanation of Cataloguing Practice" which forms part of these terms. You can find a key to the Symbols found next to certain catalogue entries under the section of the catalogue called "Symbols Used in this Catalogue".
- (b) Our description of any lot in the catalogue, any condition report and any other statement made by us (whether orally or in writing) about any lot, including about its nature or condition, artist, period, materials, approximate dimensions, or provenance are our opinion and not to be relied upon as a statement of fact. We do not carry out in-depth research of the sort carried out by professional historians and scholars. All dimensions and weights are approximate only.

2 OUR RESPONSIBILITY FOR OUR DESCRIPTION OF LOTS

We do not provide any guarantee in relation to the nature of a lot apart from our **authenticity warranty** contained in paragraph E2 and to the extent provided in paragraph I below.

3 CONDITION

- (a) The condition of lots sold in our auctions can vary widely due to factors such as age, previous damage, restoration, repair and vear. Their nature means that they will rarely be in perfect condition. Lots are sold "as is," in the condition they are in at the time of the sale, without any representation or warranty or assumption of liability of any kind as to condition by Christic's to the seler.
- Any reference to condition in a catalogue entry or in a condition report will not amount to a full description of condition, and images may not show a lot clearly. Colours and shades may look different in print or on screen to how they look on physical inspection. Condition reports may be available to help you evaluate the condition of a lot. Condition reports are provided free of charge as a convenience to our buyers and are for guidance only. They offer our opinion but they may not refer to all faults, inherent defects, restoration, alteration or adaptation because our staff are not professional restorers or conservators. For that reason condition reports are not an alternative to examining a lot in person or seeking your own professional advice It is your responsibility to ensure that you have requested, received and considered any condition report

4 VIEWING LOTS PRE-AUCTION

- (a) If you are planning to bid on a lot, you should inspect it personally or through a knowledgeable representative before you make a bid to make sure that you accept the description and its condition. We recommend you get your own advice from a restorer or other professional adviser.
- (b) Pre-auction viewings are open to the public free of charge. Our specialists may be available to answer questions at pre-auction viewings or by appointment.

5 ESTIMATES

Estimates are based on the condition, rarity, quality and provenance of the lots and on prices recently paid at auction for similar property. Estimates can change. Neither you, nor anyone eke, may rely on any estimates as a prediction or guarantee of the actual selling price of a lot or its value for any other purpose. Estimates do not include the **buyer's premium** or any applicable taxes.

6 WITHDRAWAL

Christie's may, at its option, withdraw any **lot** from auction at any time prior to or during the sale of the **lot**. Christie's has no liability to you for any decision to withdraw.

7 JEWELLERY

- (a) Coloured genutones (such as rubies, supplices and emeralds) may have been treated to improve their look, through methods such as heating and oiling. These methods are accepted by the international jewellery trade but may make the genutone less strong and/or require special care over time. (b) All types of genutones may have been improved
- (a) This types of germonias may have even improved by some method. You may request a germonological report for any item which does not have a report if the request is made to us at least three weeks before the date of the auction and you pay the fee for the report.

- (d) For jewellery sales, estimates are based on the information in any gemmological report. If no report is available, assume that the gemstones may have been treated or enhanced.

8 WATCHES & CLOCKS

- (a) Almost all clocks and watches are repaired in their lifetime and may include parts which are not original. We do not give a warranty that any individual component part of any watch is authentic. Watchhands described as "associated" are not part of the original watch and may not be authentic. Clocks may be sold without pendulums, weights or keys.
- (b) As collectors' watches often have very fine and complex mechanisms, you are responsible for any general service, change of battery, or further repair work that may be necessary. We do not give a warranty that any watch is mgood working order. Certificates are not available unless described in the catalogue.
- (c) Most wristwatches have been opened to find out the type and quality of movement. For that reason, wristwatches with water resistant cases may not be waterproof and we recommend you have them checked by a competent watchmaker before use. Important information about the sale, transport and shipping of watches and watchbands can be found in paragraph Hz(0).

B REGISTERING TO BID 1 NEW BIDDERS

3 IF YOU FAIL TO PROVIDE THE RIGHT DOCUMENTS

If in our opinion you do not satisfy our bidder identification and registration procedures including, but not limited to completing any anti-money laundering and/or anti-terrorism financing checks we may require to our satisfaction, we may refuse to register you to bid, and if you make a successful bid, we may cancel the contract for sale between you and the seller.

4 BIDDING ON BEHALF OF ANOTHER PERSON

If you are bidding on behalf of another person, that person will need to complete the registration requirements above before you can bid, and supply a signed letter authorising you to bid for him/her. We must receive your completed Written Bid Form at least 24 hours before the auction. Bids must be placed in the currency of the saleroom. The auctioneer will take reasonable steps to carry out written bids at the lowest possible price, taking into account the reserve. If you make a written bid on a lot which does not have a reserve and there is no higher bid than yours, we will bid on your behalf at around 50% of the low estimate or, if lower, the amount of your bid. 3 AUCTIONEER'S DISCRETION

- The auctioneer can at his or her sole option: (a) refuse any bid;

The meaning of authentic can be found in the glossary at the end of these Conditions of Sale. The terms of the authenticity warranty are as follows:

- (a) It will be honoured for a period of 5 years from the date of the auction. After such time, we will not be obligated to honour the authenticity warranty. (b) It is given only for information shown in
- UPPERCASE type in the first line of the catalogue description (the "Heading"). It does not apply to any information other than in the Heading even if shown in UPPERCASE type
- (c) The authenticity warranty does not apply to any Heading or part of a Heading which is qualified. Qualified means limited by a clarification in a lot's catalogue description or by the use in a Heading of one of the terms listed in the section titled Qualified Headings on the page of the catalogue headed "Important Notices and Explanation of Cataloguing Practice". For example, use of the term "ATTRIBUTED TO ... " in a Heading means that the lot is in Christie's opinion probably a work by the named artist but no warranty is provided that the lot is the work of the named artist. 
