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THE AFTER LIFE OF

It meant so much in the moment - an Hermès Kelly bag in bold red, white and blue designed as a unique keepsake to mark the bicentennial of the French Revolution.

But what was bought in Paris - with its original invoice still tucked inside - back in 1989 is now looking for another patriotic owner. Or a collector.

The 'After Life' of the handbag is the fascinating subject of an inaugural sale at Christie's on 12th June in London. And it underscores the value of what may have been lying, unloved, as a forgotten treasure.

The handbags from heaven come mostly from Hermès - but also Chanel, Gucci and Fendi, with Ralph Lauren and Tom Ford adding to the collectibles. There might be a story of provenance - a bag whose handle has swung from famous fingers. But mostly it is the craft work of these fine objects that draws Senior Director Matthew Rubinger to put these pieces up for auction at his company's King Street, London, headquarters.

What makes an object of desire in the realm of handbags? There is the craftsmanship, of course, which is proven by the creative jigsaw that brings together dozens of pieces of leather or exotic skins.

There is also that warm, fuzzy feeling that this expensive purchase will only become more valuable as time increases its rarity.

But mostly it is not just the design, quality, fine handwork and historic rarity that will seal a sale - but the heart beat that quickens for something so infinitely desirable.

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
