For Only Watch, Agenhor presents Carpe Diem, powered by the very first production AgenGraphe® movement manufactured and delivered by Agenhor. Carpe Diem is a fully functioning desk clock and chronograph that can be orientated through 360 degrees: instead of hands, five rotating disks display time and elapsed time.

Agenhor is a movement supplier, not a brand; this truly unique piece has been designed in collaboration with students at the Geneva University of Art and Design (HEAD), who imagined a transparent ball magnifying the beauty of this next-generation chronograph movement. The concept of highlighting what's normally hidden is inspired by the vibrant minds and personalities of children with Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy.

Agenhor revisited its new chronograph for the students of the Watch Design class at HEAD (Haute Ecole d'Art et de Design of Geneva) to imagine a unique timepiece of art. Fourteen students worked in pairs over three weeks.

The project designed by Bérénice Noël and Florian Wicki was unanimously acclaimed by the team working on this exceptional endeavor: Luc Pettavino (Only Watch), Jean-Marc Wiederrecht (Agenhor), Valérie Ursenbacher (HEAD), Technew (Packaging company) and the designer and PM Serena Trabalza.

The Carpe Diem concept was selected for its «on the outside looking into inner beauty» approach, which the jury felt reflected living with Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy.

This escapement is extremely efficient and requires less energy than traditional lever escapements, offering gains in terms of longevity and stability in everyday use.

The sublimely elegant balance-bridge offers an unobstructed view of the escapement and balance. It also allows the enthusiast to admire the synchronised movements of the escape-wheels.

Finishing of the watch is of the very highest standard. The surfaces of pinions and wheels are totally flat and perfectly polished to exceptionally uniform tolerances. All finishing work on the main plate and bridges is carried out by hand to attain the best possible surface finish. Screws and all steel surfaces are finished and polished by hand.



The Arpal One LF-UR1 also offers a unique opportunity to witness two independent brands working together to produce a watch for the Only Watch 2017 auction. Laurent Ferrier has forged an enviable reputation as master of the definitive watch in the classic style. URWERK, on the other hand, has spent the last 20 years challenging the watchmaking world with its bold originality.

COLLABORATION



The story started behind the watchmaking scenes. It was in November 2015 at a watchmaking exhibition like many others. There, two watchmakers, exiled from the cocoons of their respective workshops, made a tentative effort to escape the crowds and take a break. "Of course, I knew him by sight. But there, we seemed to be alone in the world, lost in a bubble, and so we got to know one another." recalls Felix Baumgartner. Laurent Ferrier picks up the story: "I'm rather shy by nature, but I quickly found common ground with Felix. The place was peculiar, but the time was right."

Their friendship was to blossom into a joint project — to build a bridge between two watchmaking companies and thereby to create an exceptional watch for a noble cause. Combining tradition with daring innovation was like mixing oil and water.



François Czapek was a Czech-born Polish watchmaker who fled to Geneva in 1832 after fighting in the ill-fated Polish uprising. He immediately started his own atelier and in 1839 entered into a partnership with Antoine Norbert de Patek, introducing him to the world of watchmaking. In 1845, at the end of their partnership, he created Czapek & Cie and achieved considerable success. He became the official watchmaker of Napoleon III and opened what was most likely the first watchmaking boutique on the Place Vendôme in Paris. He wrote a book about watchmaking, one of the first ever written in Polish but unfortunately died before publishing a second one.

Czapek & Cie has been revived in 2015 with an exceptional collection, whose leading model won the Public Prize in the Grand Prix de l'Horlogerie in Geneva in November 2016. This collection takes its inspiration from a 1850s Czapek time piece. It features a beautiful enamel dial and is powered by a 7-day proprietary movement, perfectly combining craftsmanship, design, exclusivity and rarity. 



PAUL PETTAVINO: YOU ARE MISSED, MY FRIEND



wo years ago, Paul Pettavino was a student of mine at the École du Journalisme (EDJ) in Nice. Funny, clever and always the first one to volunteer to participate, whether for the "Today's News" segment or a game, you would have thought he was like any one of the 74 other young budding journalists of his year. Except Paul had Duchenne muscular dystrophy (DMD) and lived in a stand-up power wheelchair.

I was deeply saddened to learn that this lovely young man died on Saturday, November 12, 2016, just shy of his 21st birthday.

While other students in my classes would hand in assignments late with the excuse that they couldn't find printing paper or when confronted about plagiarism would reply, "I couldn't have plagiarised because my mom wrote my paper", Paul was battling his physical constraints on a minute-by-minute basis, never complaining. He gave me hope.

His level of English comprehension was higher than most of his peers, and often when I'd make a joke in English under my breath, I would look at him for a response, and be rewarded with a grin. "We thought we had to help Paul," Nicolas Allera, a fellow journalism student from Paul's first year, tells Monaco Life, "but in fact Paul was always helping us. He never put his disease on other people and he was always smiling."

Open-minded, smart and always telling jokes in class, Nicolas adds that "Paul wanted to show us and himself that he was just a regular kid in the class."

Another EDJ student, Laura Berlioz, started a "cagnotte", a donation box, to collect money for the Monegasque Muscular Dystrophy Association (Association Monégasque contre les Myopathies), launched by Paul's father, Luc, in 2001.

Mr Pettavino, who was managing director the Monaco Yacht Show for 18 years until 2010, is also Chairman of the

Board at Synthena, a biotech company in Bern, Switzerland, which aim is to develop life-saving drugs for the treatment of severe neuromuscular diseases in general and Duchenne muscular dystrophy in particular.

The 6th edition of the Only Watch charity auction held November 7, 2015, showcased a collection of "44 exceptional one-off timepieces".

Paul himself worked with Louis Vuitton four times over the years, designing special watches for the occasion. In 2015, his "World is a dance floor" (complete with Night Fever dance floor pattern on the dial, pictured) was a variation of Louis Vuitton's Escale Worldtime, and in 2013, he created the Tambour Regatta Spin Time watch.

Held at La Réserve in Geneva, Only Watch, which is under the High Patronage of HSH Prince Albert II, raised €10,450,000 in 2015 for DMD research, making it the association's most successful fundraiser to date.

Paul, who grew up in Monaco and attended Lycée Albert 1er, had many creative outlets. Just over a year ago, he had his first photography exhibition at Le Teashop at Place des Moulins. In a tribute to Jack Kerouac, "On the Road" unveiled a collection of Paul's photos from a 2014 trip to the US and Canada, where he visited Boston, New York, Washington, Ottawa, Montreal and other cities, with a focus on architecture and urban landscapes. "I wanted to show through my exposition what I discovered," Paul said in an interview at the opening.

"Paul was truly an exceptional person, a lesson in love and goodness," Le Teashop owner Sharon Eastwood tells Monaco Life.

A friend of the Pettavino family, Sharon has known Paul and his older sister, Tess, since they were born and used to babysit the two of them.

"Paul was so serene. He was a beautiful, affectionate, extremely kind, radiant, always smiling and a creative spirit," she adds. "The last time we dined together, we talked about doing the next exhibition at the Teashop on the theme of 'public benches'. He was very enthusiastic and full of ideas, as usual."

"I am very happy to have had the chance to cross his path and share some nice moments with him. He was very much surrounded with love, he has a great family and I wish them much courage to overcome this painful ordeal." Paul's Facebook page has been painted with touching tributes to such a unique individual, and as Monaco Life discreetly reached out to others that knew him, we were moved to tears by the impact he consistently made on others: "Such an unfair, destructive illness and yet this young man taught us bravery, the true essence of joy and, of course, the importance of here and now. May Paul Rest in Peace, pain free and fly little angel."




