


Marc Chagall, Colour of Life: Works Formerly from the Artist's Estate is a dedicated sale celebrating the enchanting work of Marc Chagall. There are few 20th Century artists who combined such a sensuous enjoyment of painting with such a singular vision and freedom of imagination. Over the course of his career, Chagall forged a bold path within modern art, conjuring fantastical, dream-like scenes, rooted in his own personal life and rich memories filtered through a highly idiosyncratic painterly vocabulary. His art, in every medium, dazzles us with the riches of his cultural heritage, weaving fears, hopes, comedy and tragedy into works that reflect his deep understanding of the human condition.

Central to Chagall's vision were a number of recurring themes, concerns and leitmotifs, which fascinated and beguiled him endlessly, reappearing in various forms and guises across the decades. This selection of works explores several key strands that dominated his *oeuvre*: the rhythms and rituals of Vitebsk, the town of his youth; the dazzling, tragicomic world of the circus; the heroic figures of myth, legend and religion; the universal questions of identity and legacy; and above all else, the enduring power of love. Not only the romantic love he portrays in the forms of floating couples or maternités, but the wider love that embraces all of mankind and all living things: 'Everything can and will be transformed in life and in art, if we speak the word love without shame...In it lies true art: that is my technique, my religion; the new and old religion handed down to us from times long past' (Chagall quoted in F. Meyer, *Marc Chagall,* London, 1964, p. 591).

It is a great honour for Christie's to be entrusted with this rare grouping of work, formerly in the artist's estate and never before offered for sale. 








