The unique and inimitable design of the Pasha immediately became an icon of Cartier, perhaps also due to the history linked to its creation. The beginning is said to have taken place on the explicit request of a sultan of Marrakech also called, precisely, Pasha. In 1933 after passing numerous tests, the sultan El Glaoui got its "special" Tank, lately named Pasha and from 1943 this specific model entered in Cartier's catalogues. The present Pasha reference 820903 emanates power and elegance characterized by its round yellow gold case, the "Vendôme"-type lugs, the graduated unidirectional bezel and the iconic blue cabochon screw and fixed to the case by a small chain. The silvered dial is decorated with quarter arabic numerals and central square with minute track border. Very rare and somehow alternative, this Pasha is outstanding for personality and beauty and comes with its original box.

For many collectors and enthusiasts of wristwatches, the Cartier Santos was the first ever wristwatch in terms of the idea and the initial execution, instead of strapping a pocket watch on the wrist. The lot here offered is a specimen of reference 1575, which was introduced in the early 1990s and is one of the variations inspired from the first Santos. The two body, solid square case in platinum is finely preserved, with back fixed with 4 screws on the band, cabochon sapphire-set winding-crown. The beautiful guilloché dial features the Cartier secret signature at 7 o'clock and painted radial Roman numerals and outer minute track.

The Cartier Tank is one of the most iconic models not only for the French brand but also for the watchmaking history of the 20th Century. Released in 1929, the Tank Obus is known for its unusual shape. Unlike other watches in the Tank line, the Obus is square, not the rectangular shape that many collectors have come to expect. But the most distinctive element of this watch is the shape of the lugs, which look nothing more like tiny bullets affixed to the ends of the case. The present example of Obus is one of the most interesting since is the version with a very wide bezel. Founded by Louis-François Cartier in Paris in 1847, the legendary firm, from its beginnings, has been associated with exquisite craftsmanship and classic, sophisticated elegance. The Tank Louis Cartier was first made in 1922 and the original model, worn by Louis Cartier himself, came with rounded shoulders, which gave it an Art Deco Style. This model is now considered one of the most iconic of Cartier and over these more than 100 years many editions have been realized. The present 18k yellow gold watch is smaller than the original one and is called mini-tank for ladies, presents the same rectangular shape with rounded corners, snap-on case-back, stepped rounded bezel, cabochon blue sapphire-set winding-crown in a smaller case of 19 x 24mm. In the 1920's with the advent of trains and automobiles, speed was everything: Louis Cartier got it immediately, understanding that the dial had to symbolize modernity. For this reason, in 1928 was introduced the first Tank with no hands, a unique digital watch that was inspired by early pocket watches with jumping hours. In these watches the glass, dial and hands were replaced by plaques, pierced with two apertures that displayed hours and minutes. Cartier also played with the position and style of the winding crown: the last two models that were released in 1997 and 2005, had the crown placed at position 3 with a cabochon, while the very early specimens had it flat at 12 o'clock like one of the later versions in yellow gold, that was released in 1996, in a limited edition of just three pieces. The present lot is part of the latter family and precisely is the number 3 as confirmed by the engravings on the back, still very deep and perfectly visible. The whole two-body yellow gold case with recessed winding crown between the curved lugs at 12 has been conserved in a fantastic way by its precedent possessor presenting no evident signs of wearing and original proportions.

The iconic case of this lot start from an idea of Louis Cartier in 1912 and recalls the silhouette of a turtle, very popular animal during that era and symbol of good fortune and longevity in many civilizations. The lot offered here is not the classic Cartier to which everybody is used to because this model is part of a special production of watches Omega realized by Cartier around the '30s. Launched in 1932 - patent no.146.310, granted 10th March 1930 - the Marine was the first watch to be tested at a depth exceeding 70 meters. The case is made in three parts with an inclined bezel at sides and with raised bar on top and bottom, with a male and female section fitting together and held in place by a large tensioned clip. Another main and very rare peculiarity of this watch is its movement, signed Omega, an unexpected and unusual but highly effective combination. The dial, with a very attractive patina capable of transforming the initial white color into an matte silver, is the only element that presents the Cartier signature. This watch is the perfect example that certainties do not exist and deserves to become part of a special collection.
