



# COVETED for COLOR

Blue and green are two of the most coveted shades among all fancy colored diamonds; in fact, the most famous jewel in the world, the Hope Diamond, features a deep blue shade. While blue diamonds get their color from the presence of boron in the stone, green diamonds are the result of millions of years underground with radioactive particles like uranium. Both hues are rarities in their own right, and natural blue-green diamonds combine the two to create intensified and unique color.



# FANCY INTENSE BLUE-GREEN DIAMOND RING Blue-green diamond: 2.88 carats

The even distribution of blue and green hues gives this jewel the perfect aqua shade. The high saturation of fancy intense and large carat weight set this ring apart. 

# FIT for ROYALTY

Once a part of the famed French Crown Jewels, this elegant necklace is crafted of Burma rubies, mine-cut diamonds and natural pearls — the most luxurious materials of its era. Purchased by Tiffany & Co. in Paris at the 1887 French Royal Crown Jewel auction, these gems hail from the most important jewel collection of the 19th century. The vast majority of the known Crown Jewels reside in the Louvre today, making this necklace an exceedingly rare find.





# ALL in the FIRM

Since the firm's inception in 1837, the legendary Tiffany & Co. has been a trailblazer in luxury design and craftsmanship. In the late 19th and early 20th century, influential figures like Louis Comfort Tiffany and George Kunz left indelible marks on the firm's output.



# EASY being GREEN

Long prized for their verdant green hue, emeralds are among the most coveted gemstones in the world. A favorite among collectors, Colombian emeralds are highly desirable for their exceptional clarity and rich "Old Mine" green color, free from any bluish tinge. The most important of these emeralds originate from the famed Muzo mines, located high in the Andes Mountains.

The central stone is joined by two white diamonds totaling 1.70 carats. The vivid green emerald, which boasts a rich color, was described by C. Dunaigre as "very rare" and "a real treasure." Only the finest out of the tens of thousands of gems seen each year are honored with such a distinction. Exceptionally free of flaws, the emerald shows only minor indications of oil. Today, 99.99% of emeralds on the market are heavily treated with oil, making the present stone an anomaly — especially for a stone so large. Certified. Set in platinum. #31-5880

## RUSSIAN EMERALD RING

Emerald: 6.29 carats

Forming a stylized floral design, the natural forest-green Russian stone is encircled by 2.00 carats of white diamonds. The production of these gems came to a halt after World War I, when the largest and best-known source of Russian emeralds, the Mariinsky Mine, became a military security zone. As a result, Russian emeralds are a rarity and a must-have for any true emerald connoisseur. Certified. Set in 18K yellow and white gold. #31-5139

# CHANGE in COLOR

Of all the optical effects a gemstone can possess, color change abilities are among the rarest and most remarkable. In essence, a color change phenomenon requires that the basic body of the gemstone transforms when the mineral is exposed to different light. From chameleon diamonds to covetable alexandrites, each gemstone is unique, with characteristics that allow ranges of hues within a single stone.





## CHAMELEON DIAMOND RING

Chameleon diamond: 1.53 carats

Demonstrating even color distribution and SI1 clarity, the chamelon diamond at the center of this ring changes colors from grayish-green to mint green when exposed to darkness or heat. The stone is flanked by two light pink diamonds totaling 0.83 carat. Set in 18K rose gold. Certified. #31-3713





# BRAZILIAN COLOR-CHANGE ALEXANDRITE RING Alexandrite: 6.21 carats

The captivating Brazilian alexandrite is remarkably large and clean, a rarity for gems of this type. The color-changing gem's olive green hue in daylight transforms to a purple color under incandescent light. Accented by diamonds totaling 0.63 carat. Certified. # RUSSIAN COLOR-CHANGE ALEXANDRITE RING Alexandrite: 4.12 carats

Hailing from the Ural Mountains of Russia, the brilliant-cut stone has been certified as a natural alexandrite, with a color change between a blueish-green hue in daylight to a purple-pink hue. Russian mines have long been depleted, making these gems highly sought after. Surrounded by white diamonds totaling 1.75 carats, the gems form a floral pattern. Certified. # SHARP as GLASS

Before the visionary became known for his innovative glasswork,
René Lalique was known as the greatest jeweler of the Art Nouveau
period. His creations echo the beauty and grace of the natural world.
Combining uncommon materials like glass and enamel, Lalique's
eclectic creations rejected traditionally gemstone-centric designs in
favor of overall aesthetics. Widely collected by museums, finding an
original piece of Lalique jewelry is a rarity.



#### LALIQUE CITRINE AND ENAMEL BROOCH

Citrine: approximately 10.00 carats

This hand-crafted treasure features elegant panels of black enamel and gold, highlighting the citrine's sunny hue. Comes in its original Lalique box. Signed "LALIQUE." Set in 18K yellow gold. 3¹/₂" length. #31-5570 ♣

#### LALIQUE GLASS AND ENAMEL NECKLACE

This glass and enamel necklace created by the artist in 1906 is a masterpiece in Art Nouveau design. It features seven cobalt-blue glass pendants. Upon each, Lalique has hand-carved and press-molded a stylized theatrical mask motif. A black and blue enamel ribbon covers the gold chain. #### ANCIENT ROMAN EMERALD BROOCH

The emerald featured in this brooch was hand-carved in ancient Rome. These gems are notoriously difficult to carve, demonstrating the skill and finesse of ancient Roman artisans.
