Standard level N-channel enhancement mode Field-Effect Transistor (FET) in a plastic package using TrenchMOS technology. The devices include TrenchPLUS diodes for ElectroStatic Discharge (ESD) protection and temperature sensing. 


Fig 1. Normalized total power dissipation as a function of mounting base temperature





Fig 2. Continuous drain current as a function of mounting base temperature




Fig 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration




Fig 5. Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values






Fig 7. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values

Fig 8. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature






Fig 9. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature





Fig 10. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage





Fig 13. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a






Fig 15. Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values

 $I_F = 250 \mu A$






Fig 16. Temperature coefficient of temperature sense diode as a function of forward voltage; typical values


