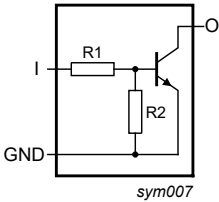

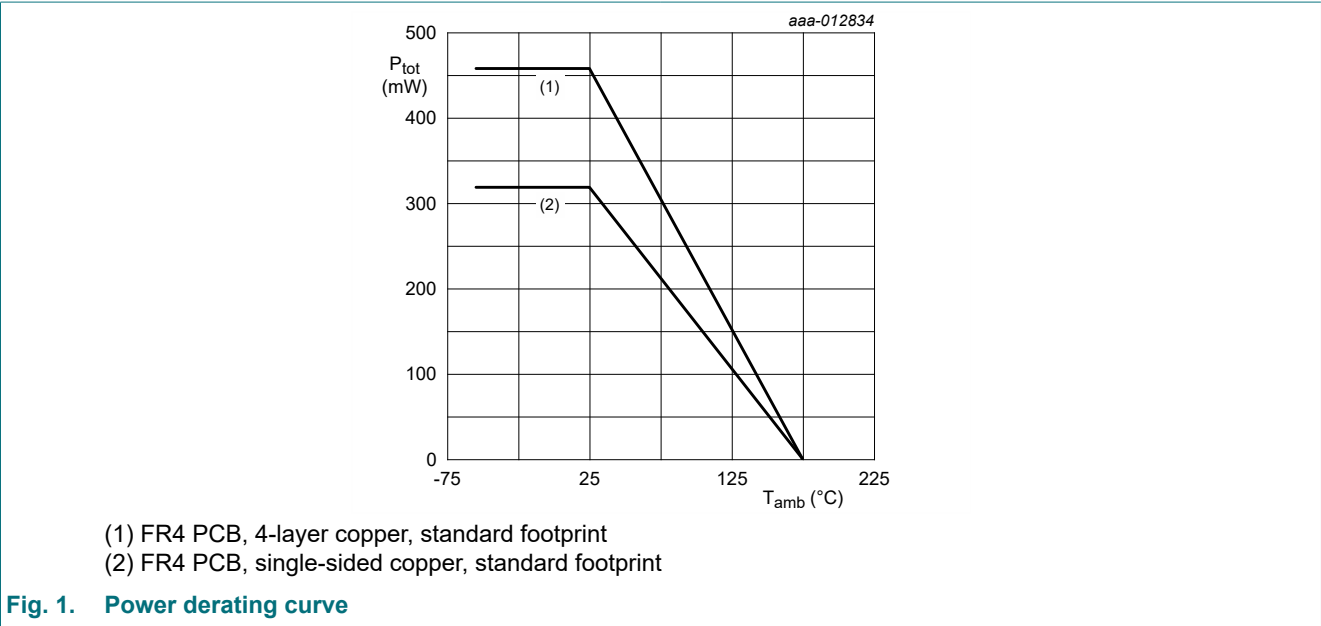

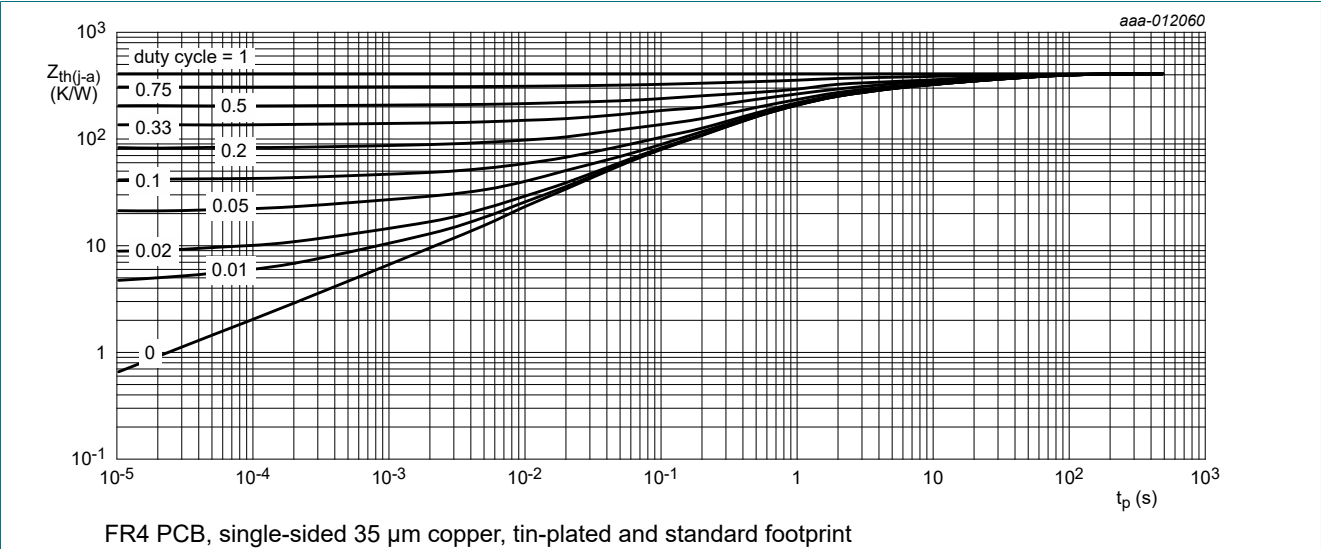


Fig. 2. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values

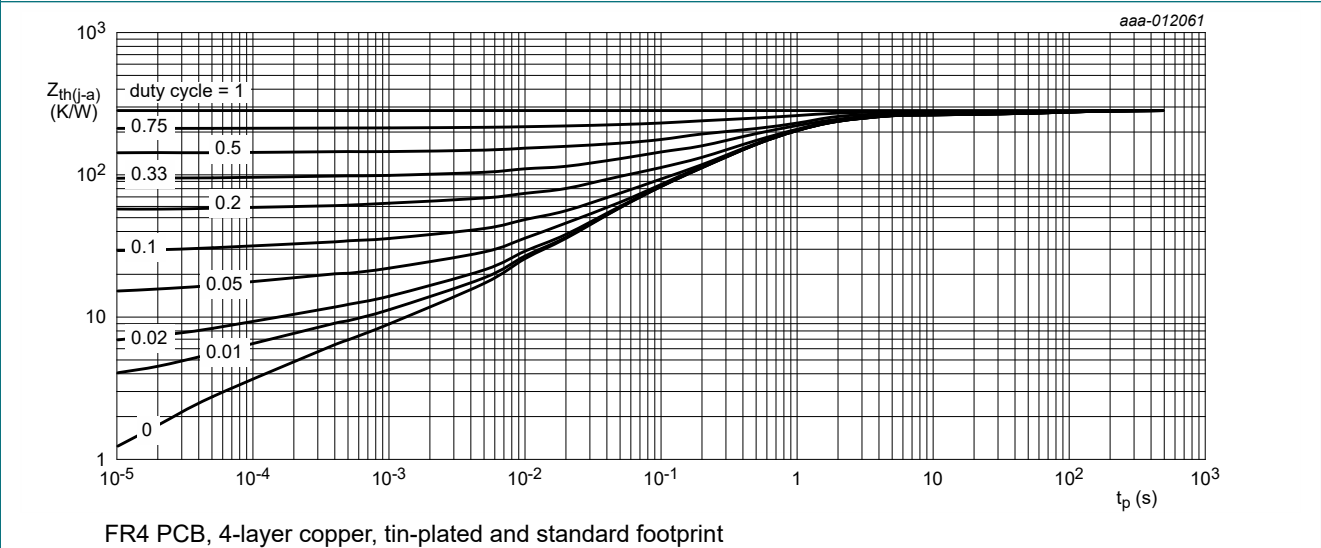


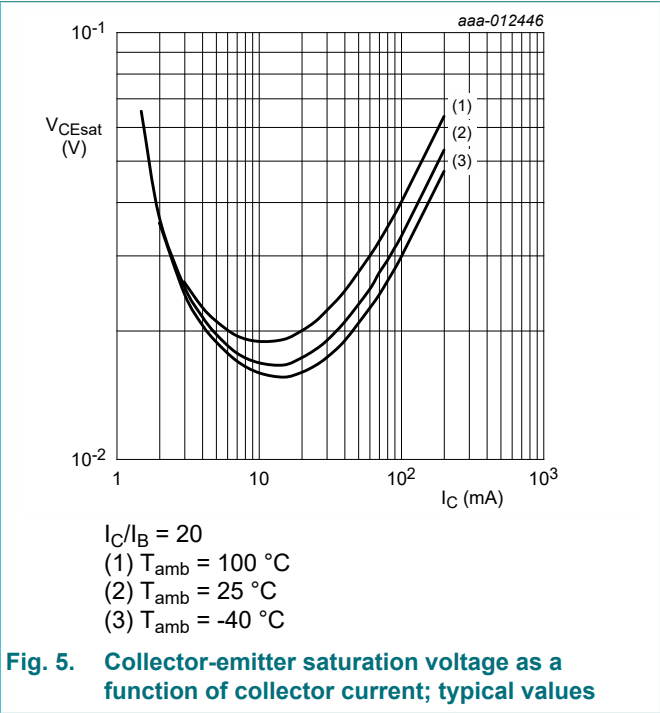
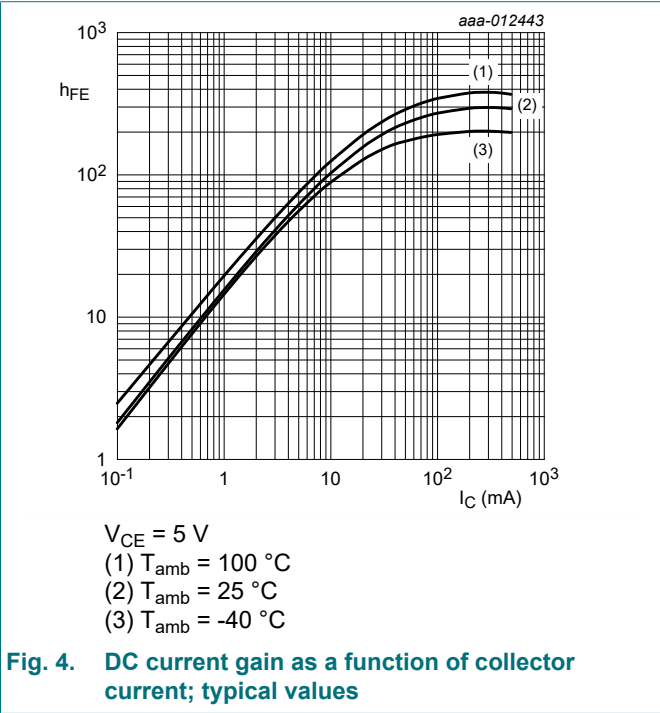
Fig. 3. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values

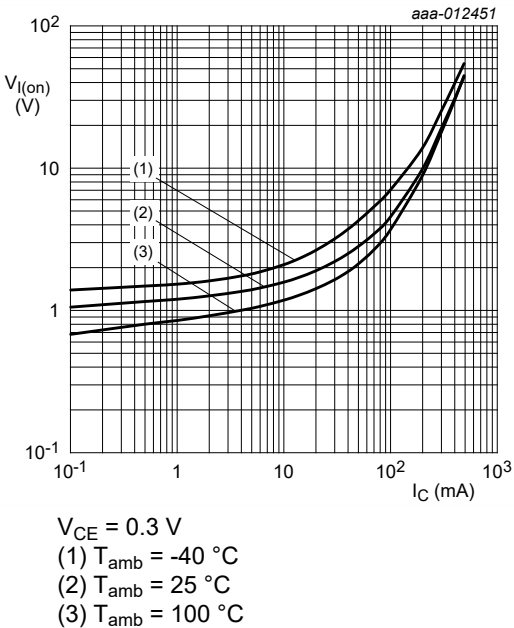


Fig. 6. On-state input voltage as a function of collector current; typical values

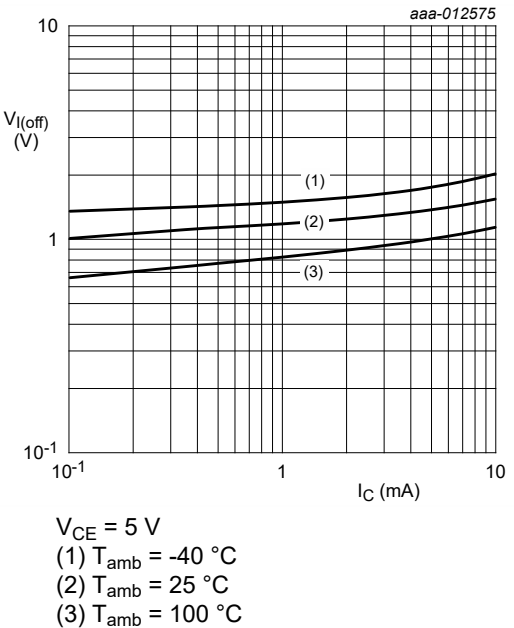


Fig. 7. Off-state input voltage as a function of collector current; typical values

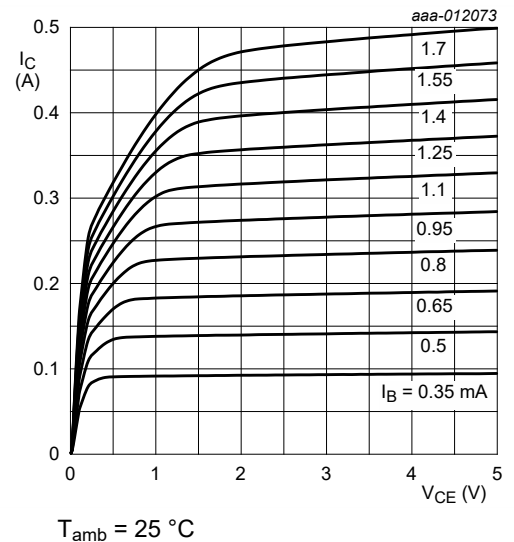


Fig. 8. Collector current as a function of collector-emitter voltage; typical values

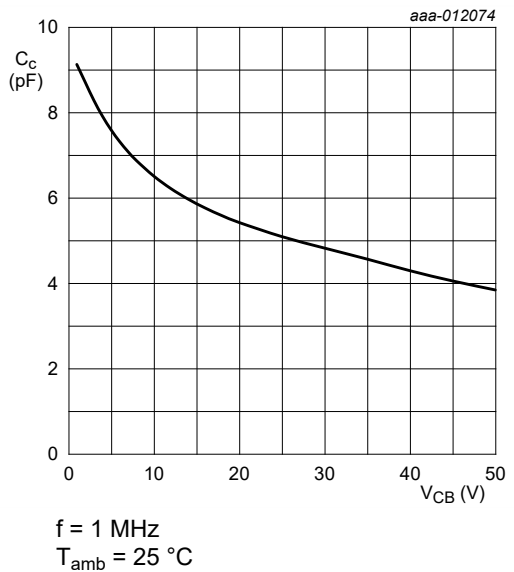
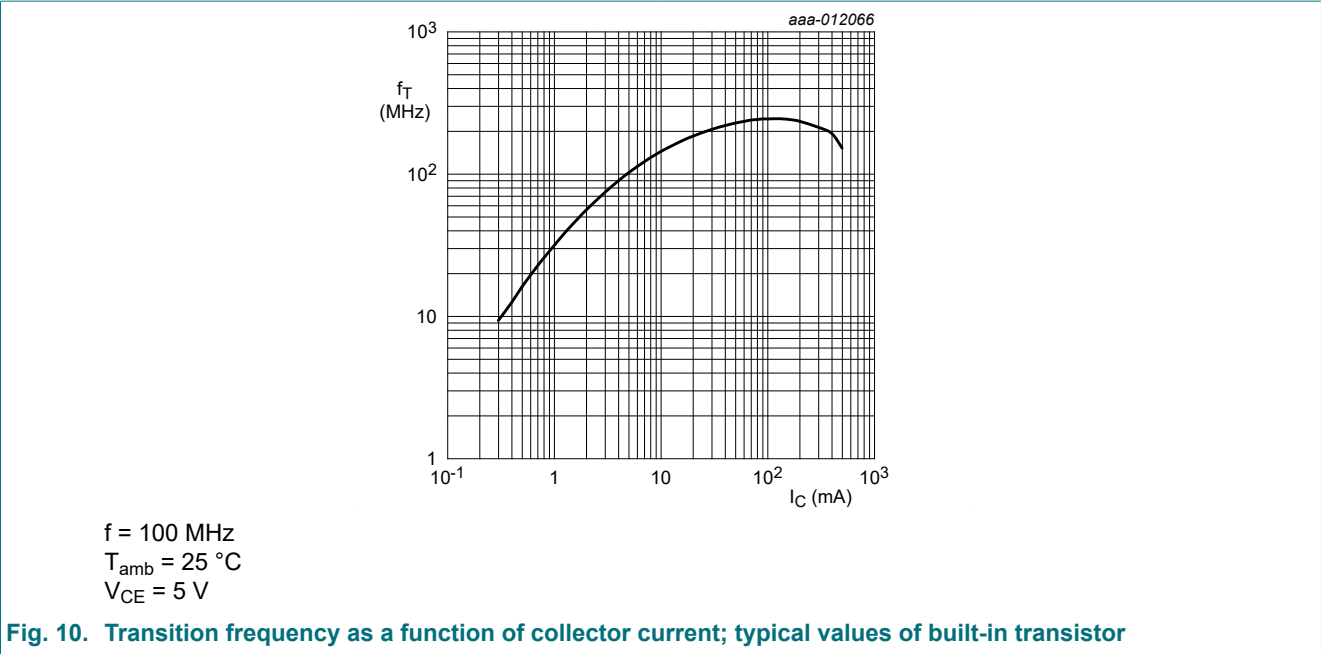


Fig. 9. Collector capacitance as a function of collector-base voltage; typical values

Resistor calculation

- Calculation of bias resistor 1 (R1)

$$R_1 = \frac{V(I_2) - V(I_1)}{I_2 - I_1}$$

- Calculation of bias resistor ratio (R2/R1)

$$\frac{R2}{R1} = \frac{V(I_4) - V(I_3)}{R1 \cdot (I_4 - I_3)} - 1$$

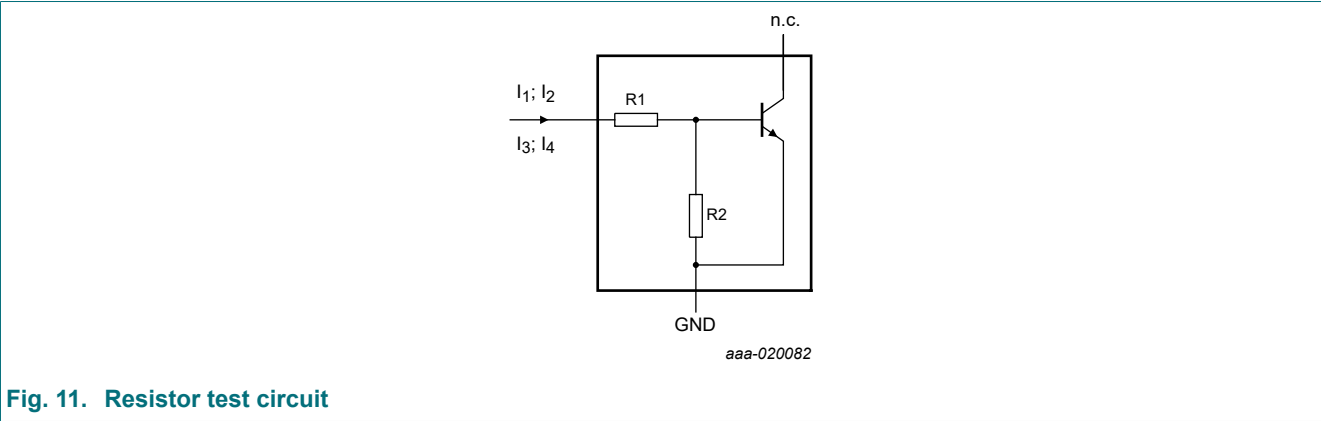


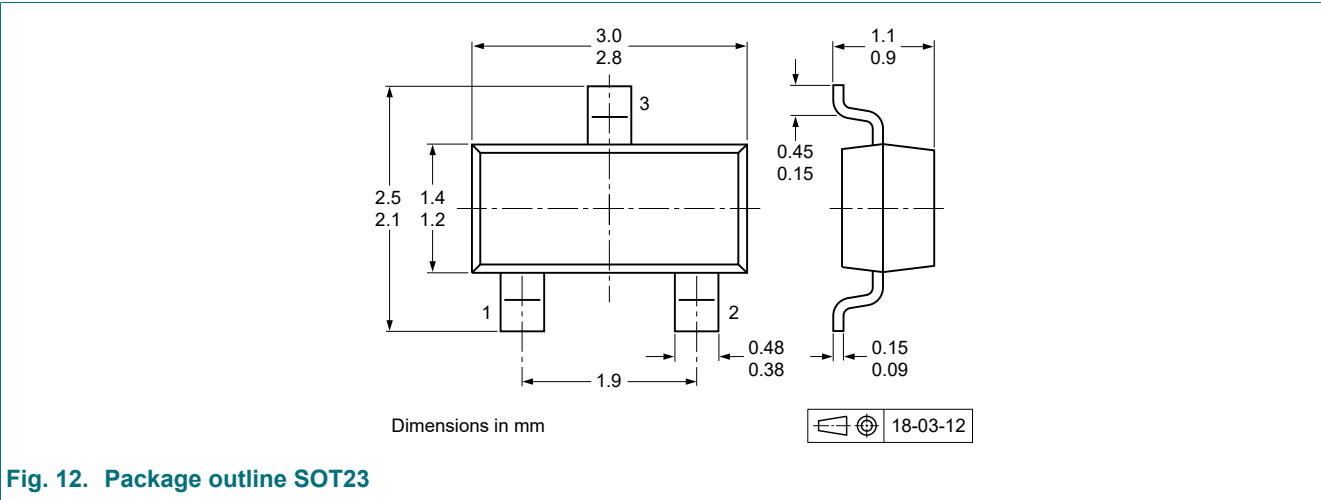
Fig. 11. Resistor test circuit

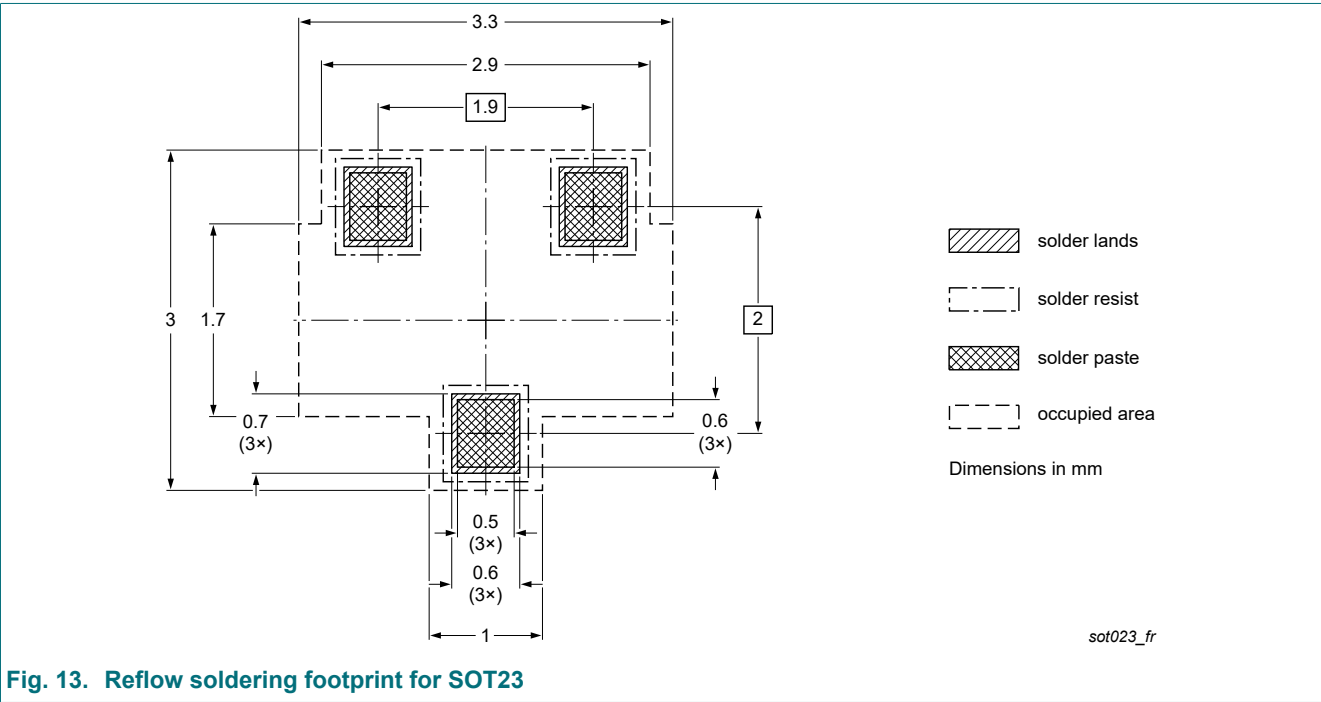

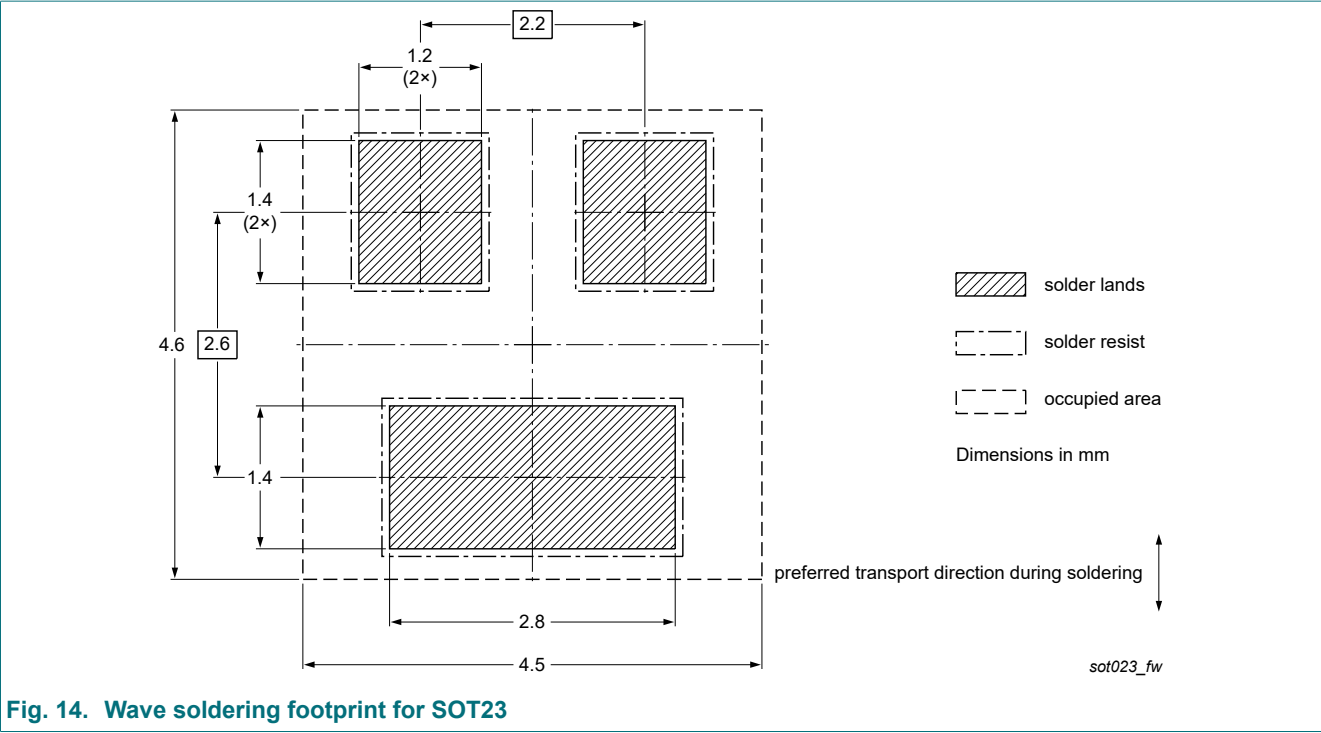


Fig. 14. Wave soldering footprint for SOT23
