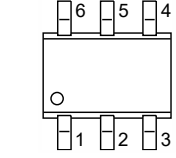
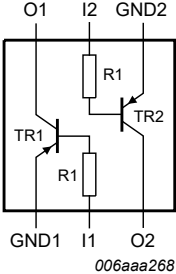

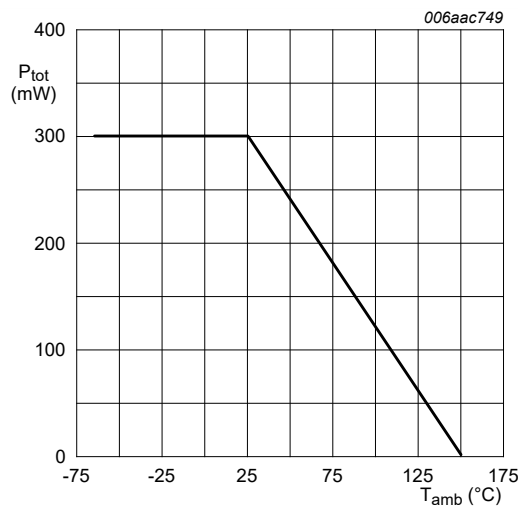

FR4 PCB, single-sided, 35 μm copper, tin-plated and standard footprint

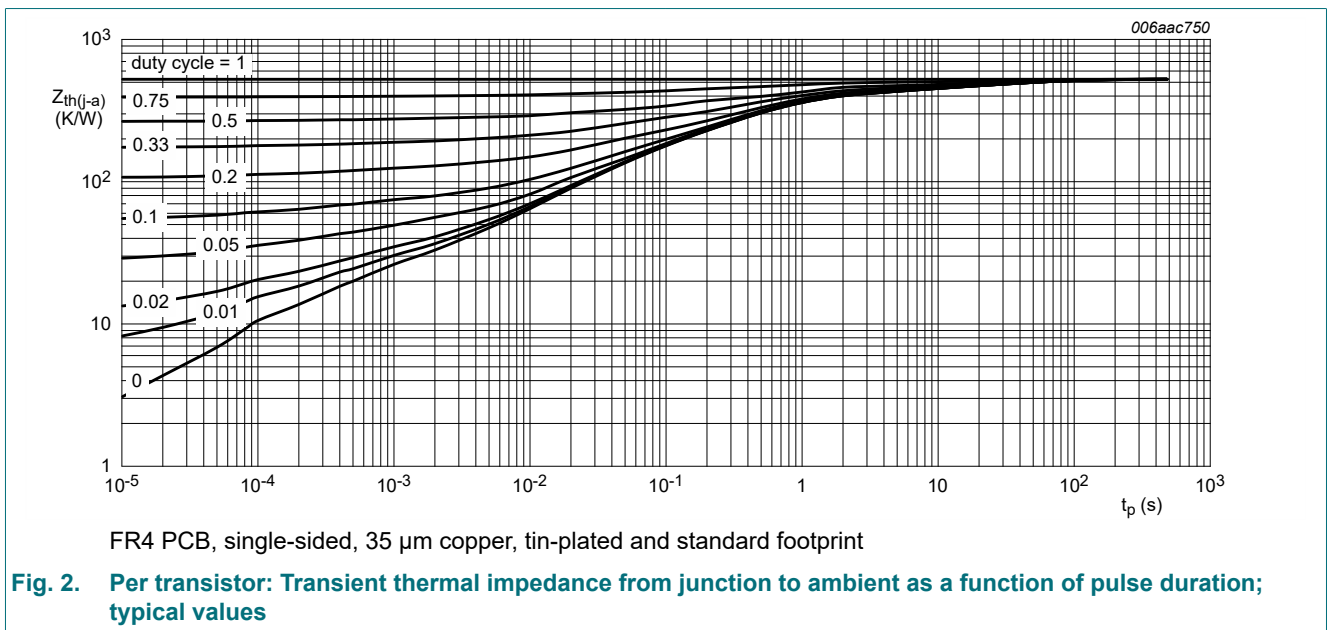
**Fig. 1. Per device: Power derating curve**

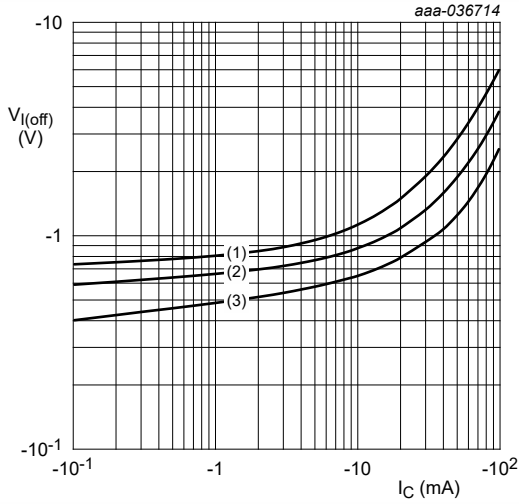

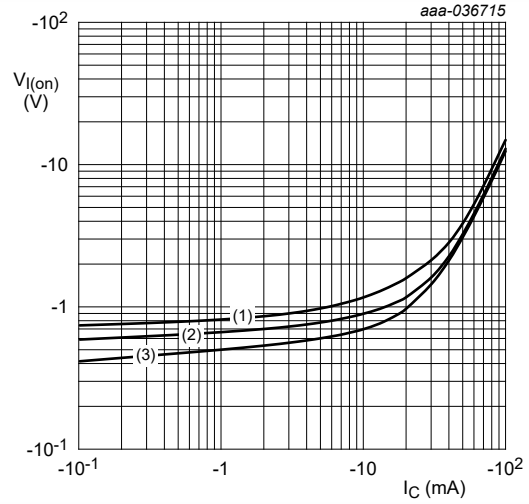

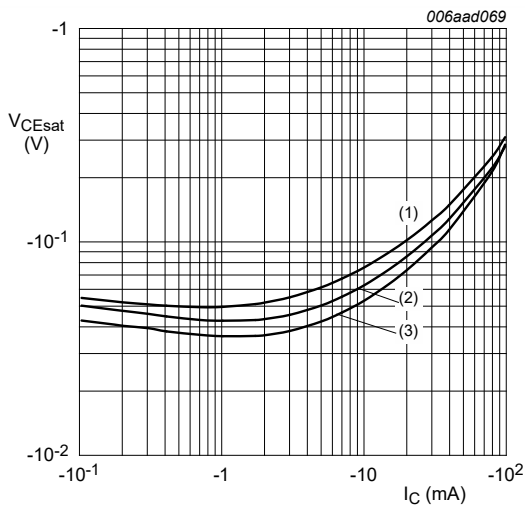

**Fig. 5. Off-state input voltage as a function of collector current; typical values**



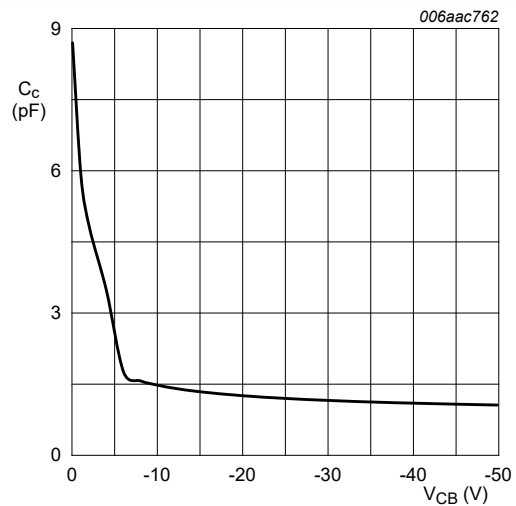

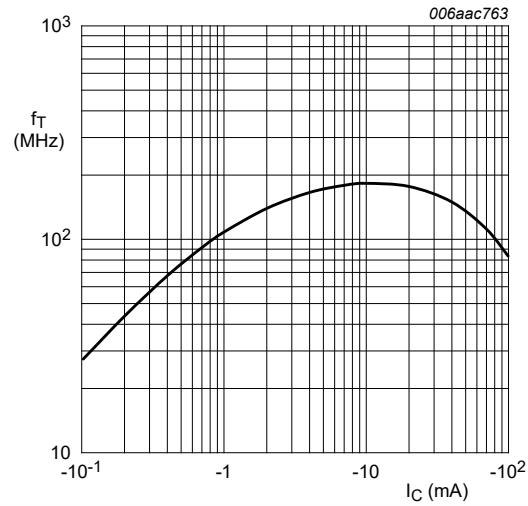
**Fig. 7. Collector-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values**

$$R_1 = \frac{V(I_2) - V(I_1)}{I_2 - I_1}$$

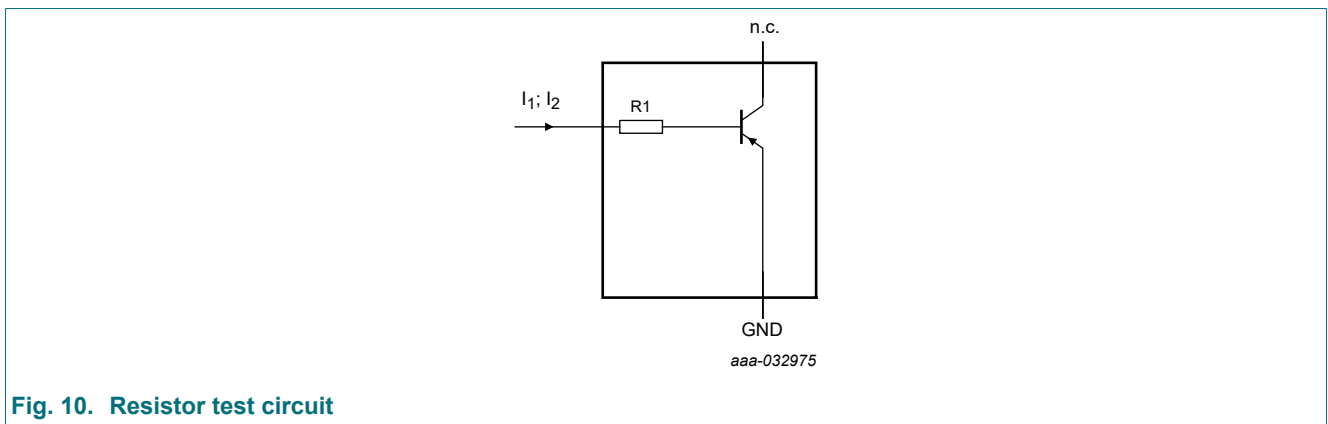


Fig. 10. Resistor test circuit

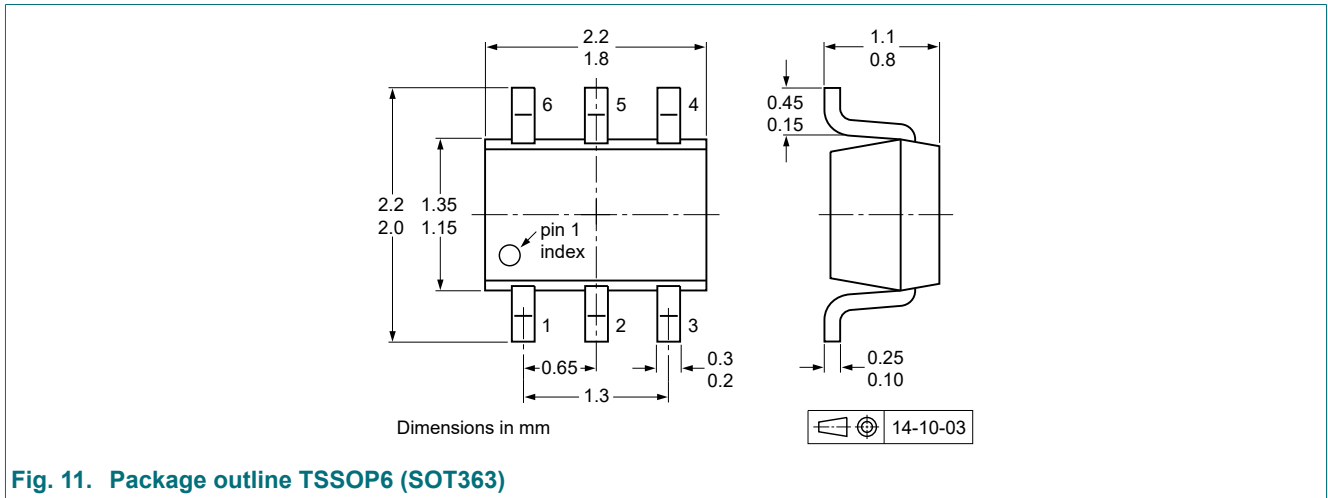


Fig. 11. Package outline TSSOP6 (SOT363)

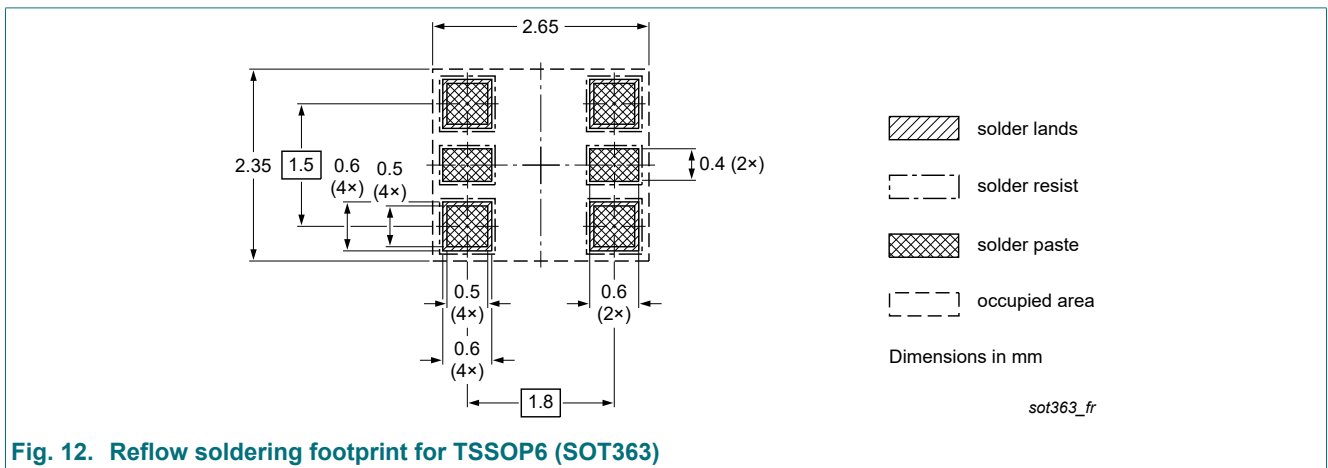


Fig. 12. Reflow soldering footprint for TSSOP6 (SOT363)

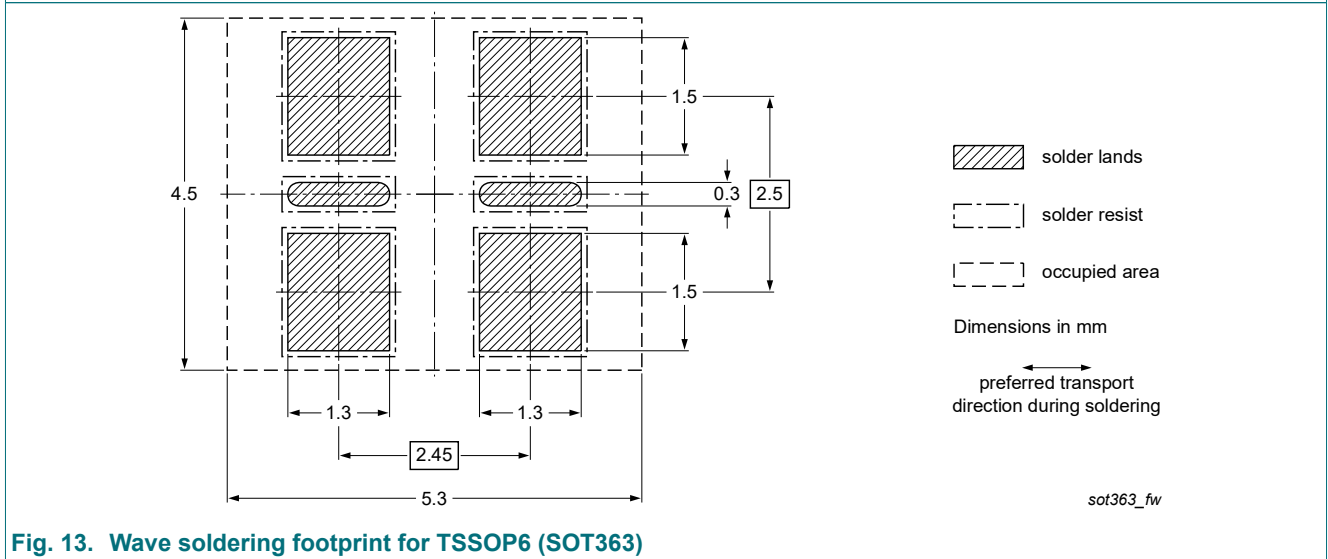


Fig. 13. Wave soldering footprint for TSSOP6 (SOT363)
