## 1. General description

Planar passivated high commutation three quadrant triac in a SOT78 (TO-220AB) plastic package intended for use in circuits where high static and dynamic  $dV/dt$  and high  $dI/dt$  can occur. This "series BT" triac will commute the full RMS current at the maximum rated junction temperature without the aid of a snubber where higher junction operating temperature capability is required.

- Higher operating temperature capability
- High immunity to false turn-on by  $dV/dt$



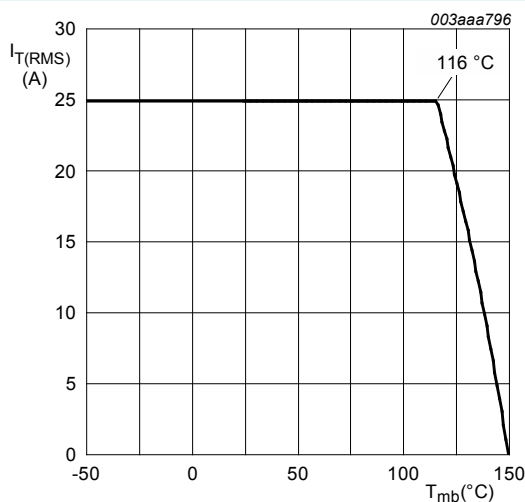

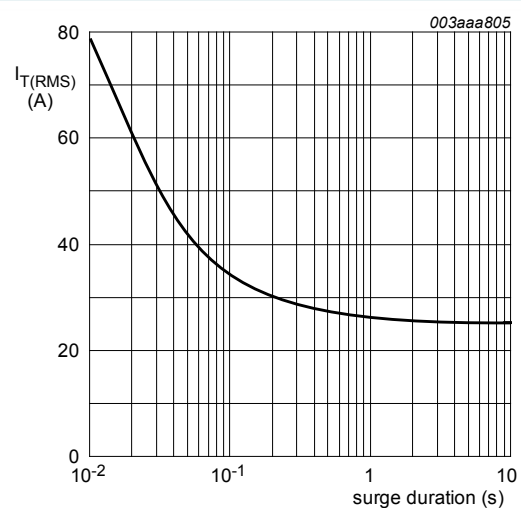

**Fig. 2. RMS on-state current as a function of surge duration; maximum values**

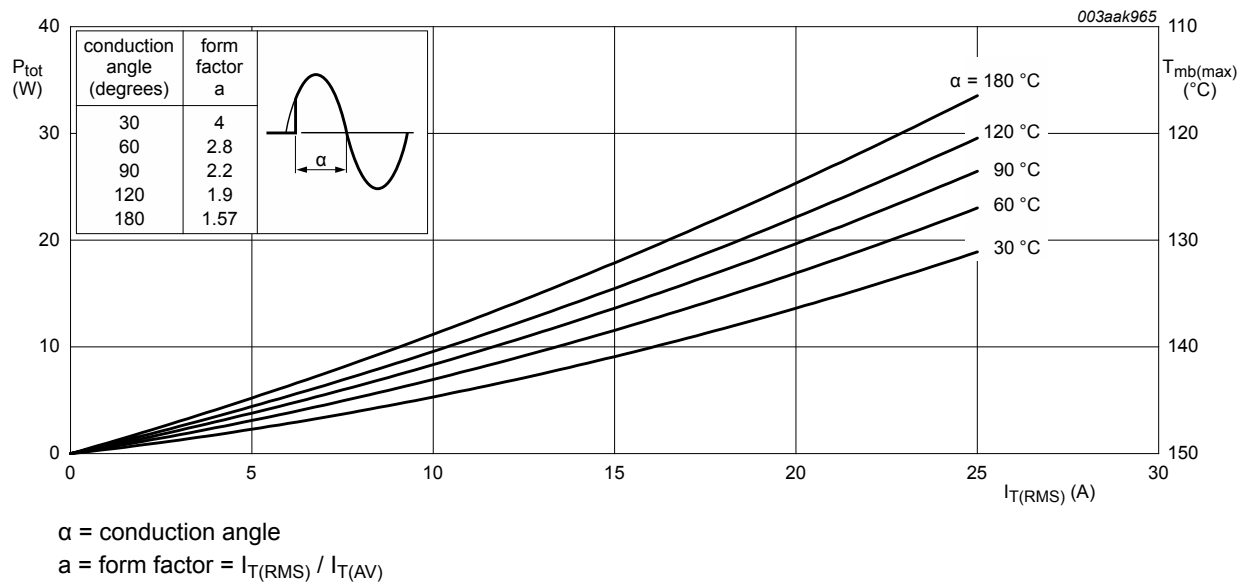


Fig. 3. Total power dissipation as a function of RMS on-state current; maximum values

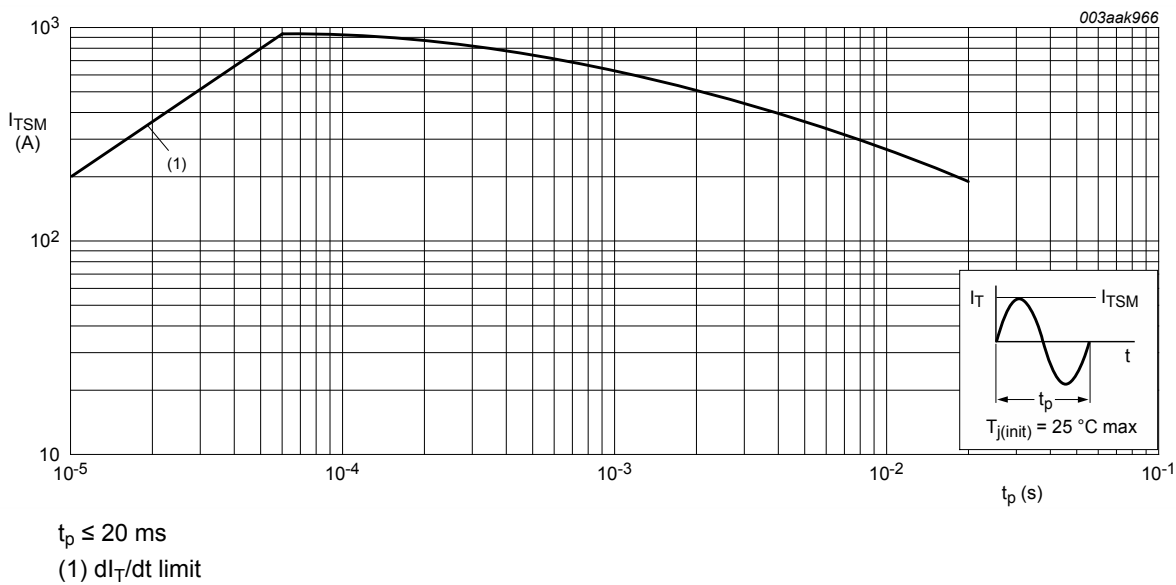
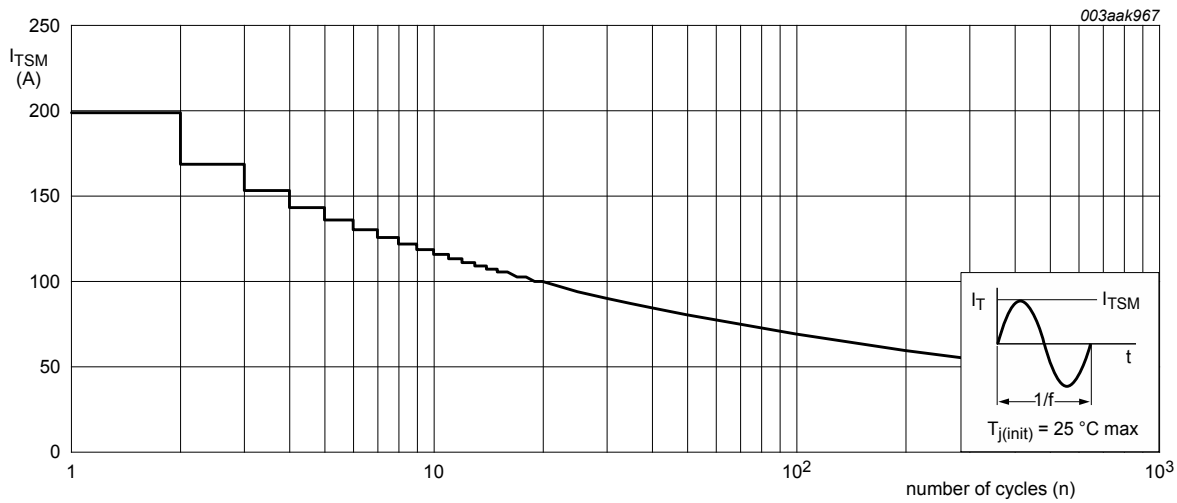


Fig. 4. Non-repetitive peak on-state current as a function of pulse duration; maximum values

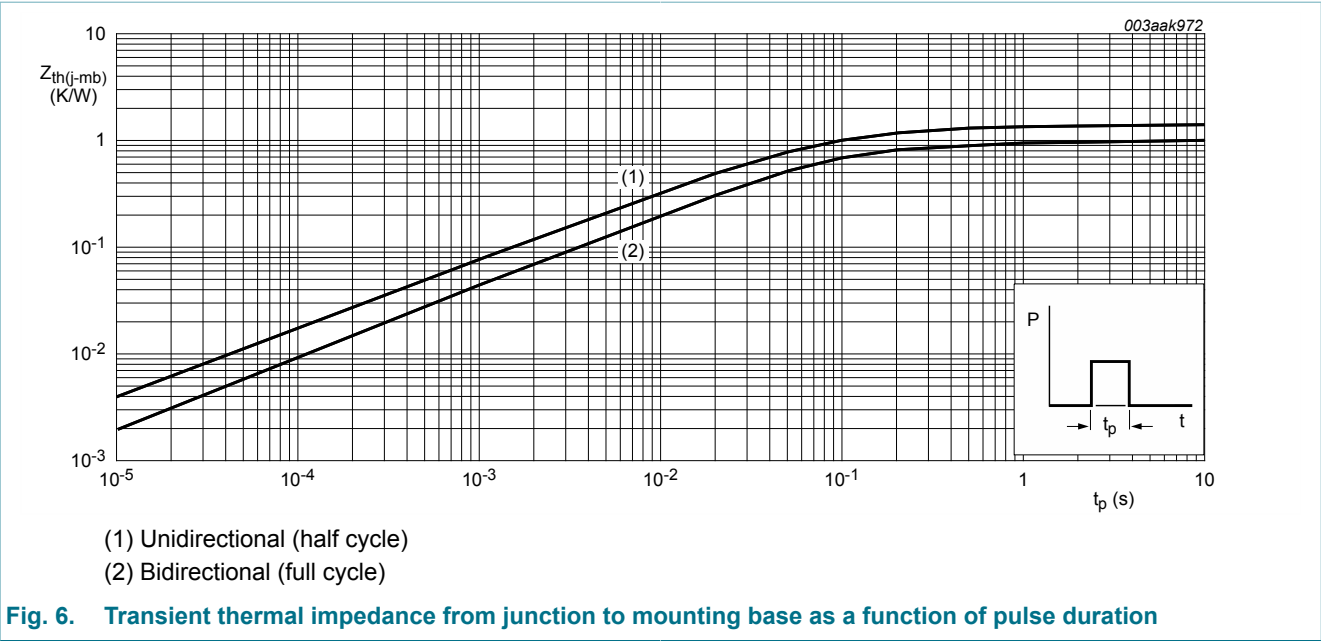


**Fig. 5. Non-repetitive peak on-state current as a function of the number of sinusoidal current cycles; maximum values**

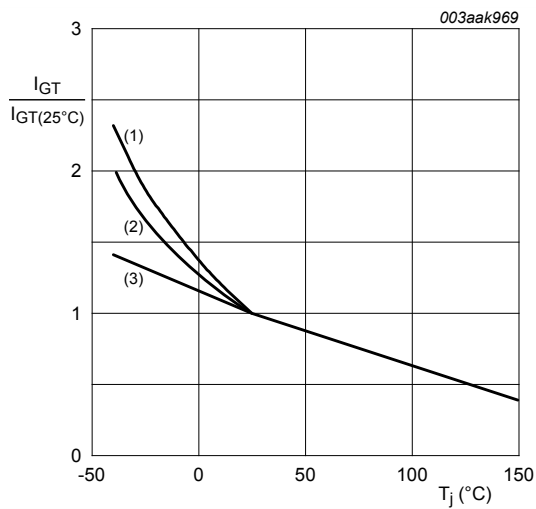

Fig. 7. Normalized gate trigger current as a function of junction temperature

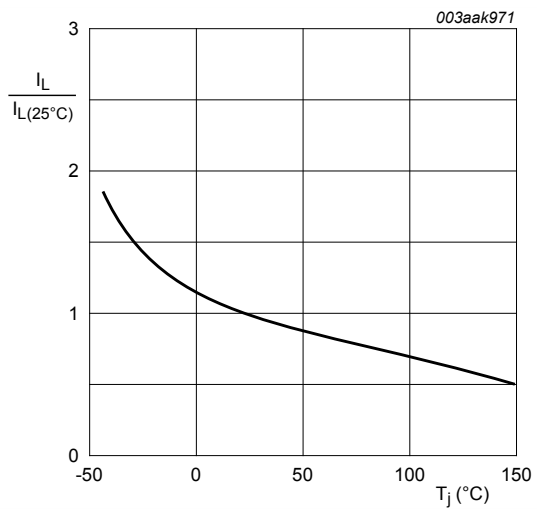


Fig. 8. Normalized latching current as a function of junction temperature

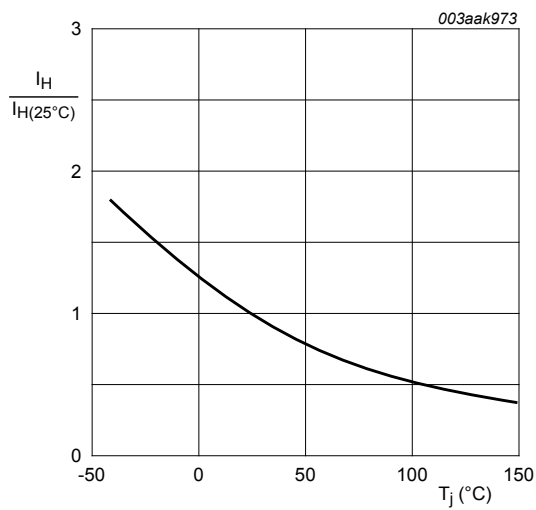
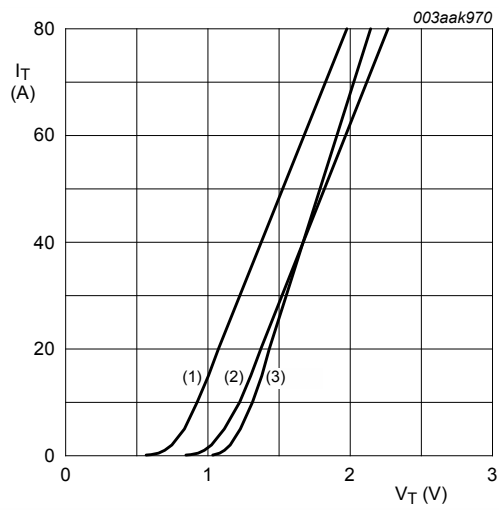


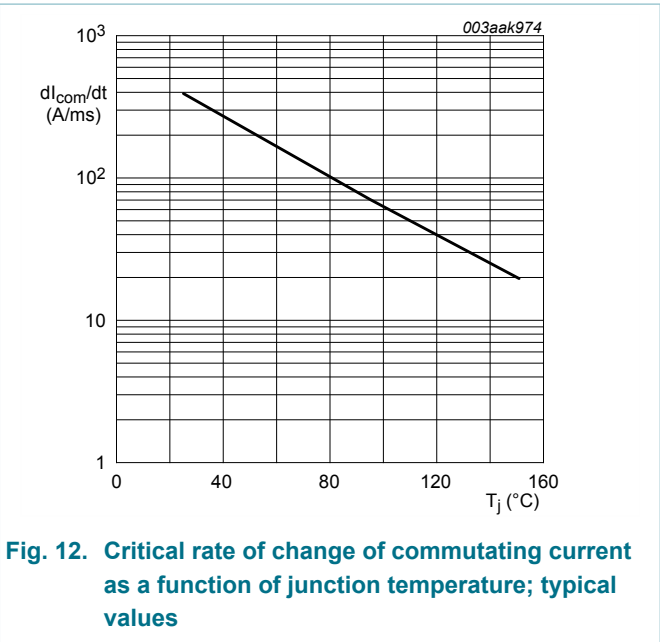
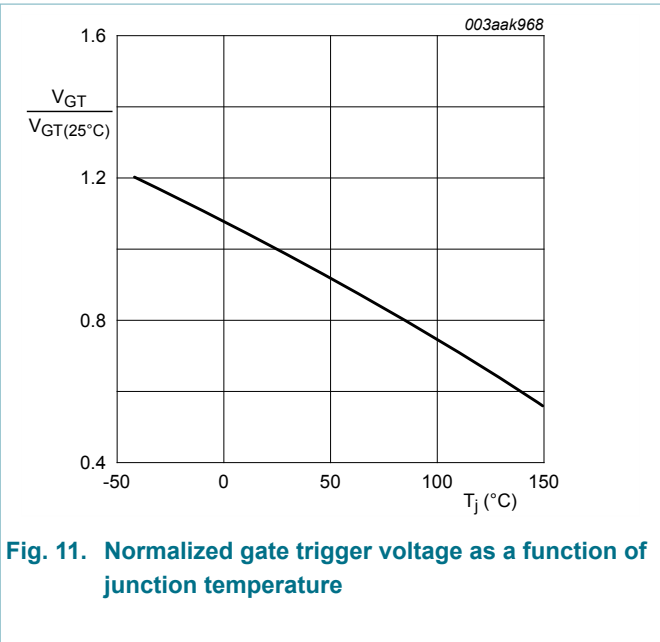
Fig. 9. Normalized holding current as a function of junction temperature

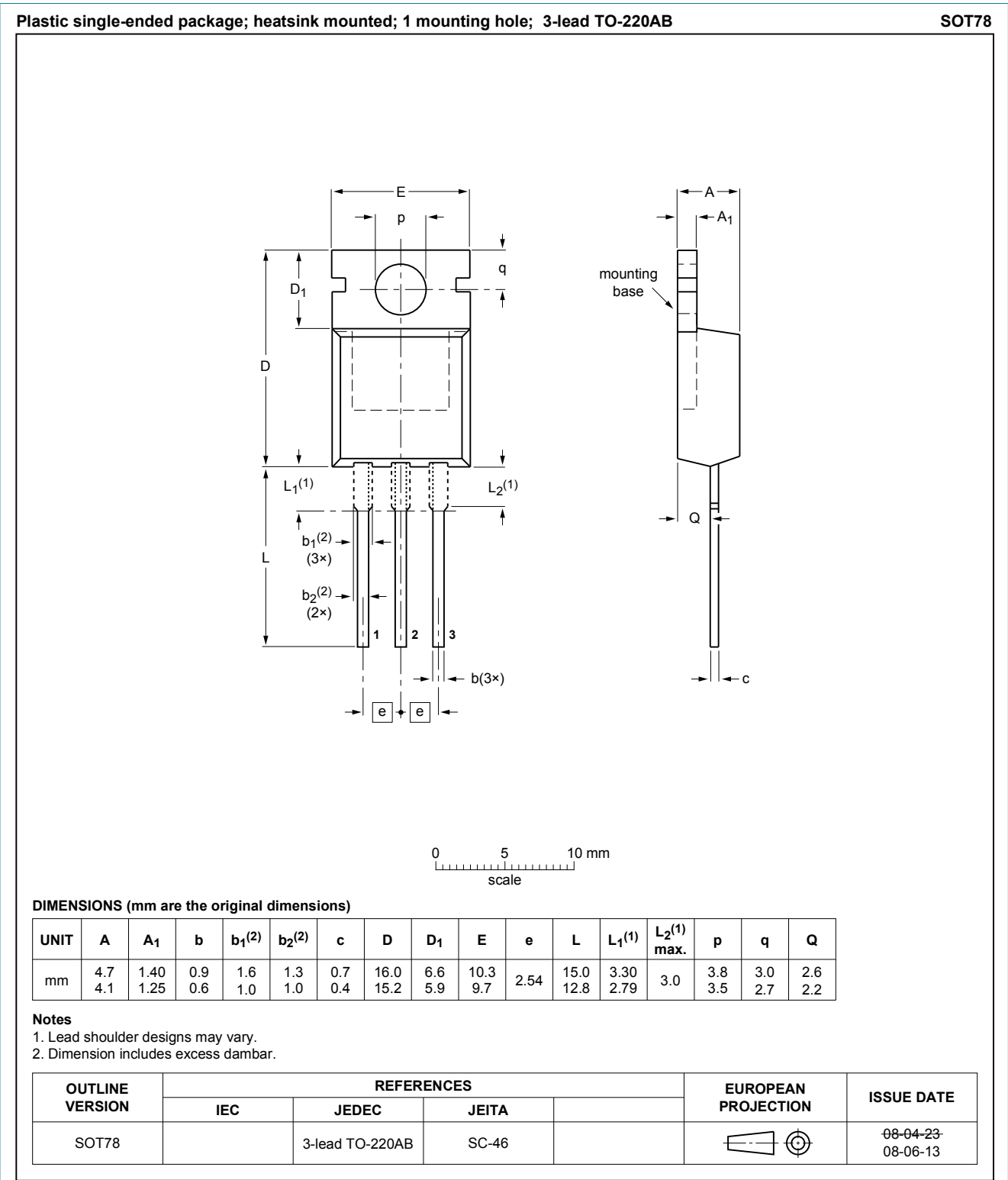


Fig. 13. Package outline TO-220AB (SOT78)
