POWER - GREEN light indicates power

DIAGNOSTIC - Flashes RED in various sequences indicating various internal trouble situations. Solid RED light indicates low battery condition. Battery should be charged immediately.

CHARGING - Yellow indicates active charging. GREEN indicates fully charged.

### **RETURN-TO-CHARGE**

Press button until beeping stops (approx. 3 - 5 seconds). Lift will raise carrybar then travel horizontally to charger docking station.

> NOTE: Ensure obstacles are cleared from path prior to operating this feature.

### POWER TRAVERSE

Press either RIGHT or LEFT button to move the lift horizontally along the track.

NOTE: Ensure path is free from obstructions while operating this feature.






Select and position the sling around the patient according to the appropriate sling application instructions.




Using the TRAVERSE buttons, move the patient horizontally along the track to desired position.
