APPROVED FOR RELEASE DATE: 23-Feb-2010 American and UN officials called on Clarence Ryee, director of the ROK Office of Public Information, in an attempt to secure official South Korean cooperation in checking the current Korean press campaign exaggerating the social and economic distress in South Korea. Ryee at first claimed that the campaign was part of the usual carping of the opposition press, but when confronted with the fact that the stories were actually initiated by pro-government papers, he shifted to a general condemnation of all Korean editors as "rascals" who changed policy daily. He agreed, however, to take the matter up with the editors at his next press conference.

Comment: The press campaign was probably inspired in part by South Korea's desire to build up its case for increased UN and American assistance in food and other consumer goods. Among other things, the press articles claimed that 9,000,000 civilians are destitute and that war destruction has reduced ROK morale to a point where attempted suicides are reaching alarming proportions. The Communists have been quick to utilize these stories in their propaganda broadcasts.
