## I. Military Situation

UN forces suffered slight reverses in two sectors during the .... past 48 hours, but the broad central front remained quiet. Strong North Korean forces in the north and east sectors succeeded in the capturing the towns of Uibung and Kigye from ROK units. "UN maval ........ activities were confined to surface patrols, close support missions, and air attacks in mortheast Kores. FEAF aircraft flew 500 missions on 27 August. A large troop concentration in the Kyumipo-Sariwon on 27 August.
