SUBJECT: Use of Headed (pre printed) Feedstock

Details:

When copying from the ADF single copies exit into the top tray to the Finisher face up, 'reversed' delivery as in the same way as a normal analogue copier.

However, when producing 'sets' of documents copies arrive in the lower tray face down but in the same orientation as the originals are placed in the ADF.

The situation has arisen whereby a customer tries one copy to ensure correct orientation, only to find that when a set of documents is produced everything is reversed.

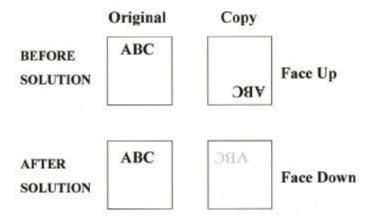
This has caused confusion for those customers who use headed paper.

Solution:

- 1. Upgrade the machine firmware to version 21 (MFC and IP). Reference K1-000031-01.
- 2. Switch off auto sort (located under custom common settings).
- 3. Select collate from the control panel.

This will cause all copies (sorted or single) to exit into the lower tray face down in the same orientation as the originals placed in the ADF.

If the customer requires it this could be set as 'standard mode'.
