**Subject**: Notes on executing the setup programs for printer and fax drivers on the hard disk.

**Reason**: This bulletin notifies of notes on copying the Windows 9x/ME setup programs for the following drivers

from the User Software CD-ROM to the hard disk of a local or server machine and executing it.

Applicable drivers: PCL5e Printer Driver v4.81, PCL6 Printer Driver v2.51, PS3 Printer Driver v1.11, and


Fax Driver v1.50

#### **Details**:


#### (Phenomenon)

After copying the printer/fax driver setup program from the User Software CD-ROM to the HD of the local PC or the server, executing either Setup.exe or Uninstall.exe displays the warning messages

shown below. (On Windows 9x/ME only.)



(After Setup.exe is executed)



(After Uninstall.exe is executed)

## (Cause)


The two files below copied from the CD-ROM to the setup folder on the HD, necessary for the setup/uninstall program, retain the read-only attribute.

- Insdrv.ini: Used for driver installation
- uninst.ini: Used for driver uninstallation

This error occurs only with the PCL53 Driver v4.81, PCL6 Driver v2.51, PS Driver v1.11, and Fax Driver v1.50 that use Windows Installer.

## (Measures)

Change the attributes of Insdrv.ini and uninst.ini on the HD from Read Only to Archive. This tip is already written in Readme.txt come by the printer/fax drivers.



# (Steps)

- (1) Select the file to change attributes of (in this case, Insdrv.ini) and right-click to display the property window.
- (2) Remove check mark of Read-only and check "Archive" of the attributes.
- (3) Click "Apply."

## (Permanent measures)

Modification is planned for later versions of the Setup and Uninstall programs.
