Procedure for the Installation of Cassette Feeding Unit -X1

Follow the instructions described below to install the cassette feeding unit -X1 to copier.

1 Components

Open the package and make sure that the following components indicated in the figure below are included.



[1] Cassette pedestal1 pc.[2] Power cable (for copier outlet)1 pc.[3] Cassette size label2 pc.[4] cable clamp1 pc.

2 Installation Procedure



Be sure to perform the following steps in sequence before starting the installation work on the host side:

- 1. Turn off the control panel power switch.
- 2. Turn off the main power switch.
- 3. Disconnect the power cable (for the outlet).



When the optional cassette heater unit is to be installed, install it before installin the cassette pedestal (see the Installation Procedure F-IM-6116).

- 1) Remove all adhesive tape attached to the machine.
- 2) Draw out the top and bottom cassettes, and remove the lengths of tape used; then, remove the holding plate retainer [1].



3) Remove the cushioning material [1] from the bottom cassettes..



- 4) Set both top and bottom cassettes.
- 5) Open the right cover [1] of the cassette pedestal.

Copier weights 100 kg. When it is lifted up, make sure to do that by 4 people.



In order to put the copier main unit on top of the cassette pedestal, align the 2 positioning pins [1] on cassette pedestal with the holes in the bottom of the copier.



- 7) Hold the 4 grips on the copier and place the copier on top of the cassette pedestal.
- 8) Remove the cover plate [1] on the lower right of the copier. (to be used later)



- 9) Close the right cover on the cassette pedestal.
- 10) Remove the screw [1] found at the lower right of the cassette pedestal; then, using the screw, mount the face plate [2].



11) Insert the connector [1] of the cassette pedestal to the copier.



12) Connect the cassette pedestal and the copier using the cable [1] that comes with the pedestal. (The cable is designed for connection to a copier outlet. Connect it to the middle of the 3 slots arranged vertically in the pedestal). Then, secure the pedestal using the cable clamp [2] that comes with the pedestal.



13) Insert one end of the power cable (for plug outlet)
[1] packed with the copier to the cassette pedestal,
and insert the other end to the plug outlet.



14) Attach the cassette size label to the cassettes according to the paper size.



After the installation, rotate the 2 adjusters [1] at the bottom of the cassette pedestal so as to securely fix the cassette pedestal.


