# Symbols Used

The following rules apply throughout this Service Manual:

1. Each chapter contains sections explaining the purpose of specific functions and the relationship between electrical and mechanical systems with reference to the timing of operation.

In the diagrams,  represents the path of mechanical drive; where a signal name accompanies the symbol, the arrow  indicates the direction of the electric signal.

The expression "turn on the power" means flipping on the power switch, closing the front door, and closing the delivery unit door, which results in supplying the machine with power.

2. In the digital circuits, '1' is used to indicate that the voltage level of a given signal is "High", while '0' is used to indicate "Low". (The voltage value, however, differs from circuit to circuit.) In addition, the asterisk (\*) as in "DRMD\*" indicates that the DRMD signal goes on when '0'.

In practically all cases, the internal mechanisms of a microprocessor cannot be checked in the field. Therefore, the operations of the microprocessors used in the machines are not discussed: they are explained in terms of from sensors to the input of the DC controller PCB and from the output of the DC controller PCB to the loads.

The descriptions in this Service Manual are subject to change without notice for product improvement or other purposes, and major changes will be communicated in the form of Service Information bulletins.

All service persons are expected to have a good understanding of the contents of this Service Manual and all relevant Service Information bulletins and be able to identify and isolate faults in the machine."



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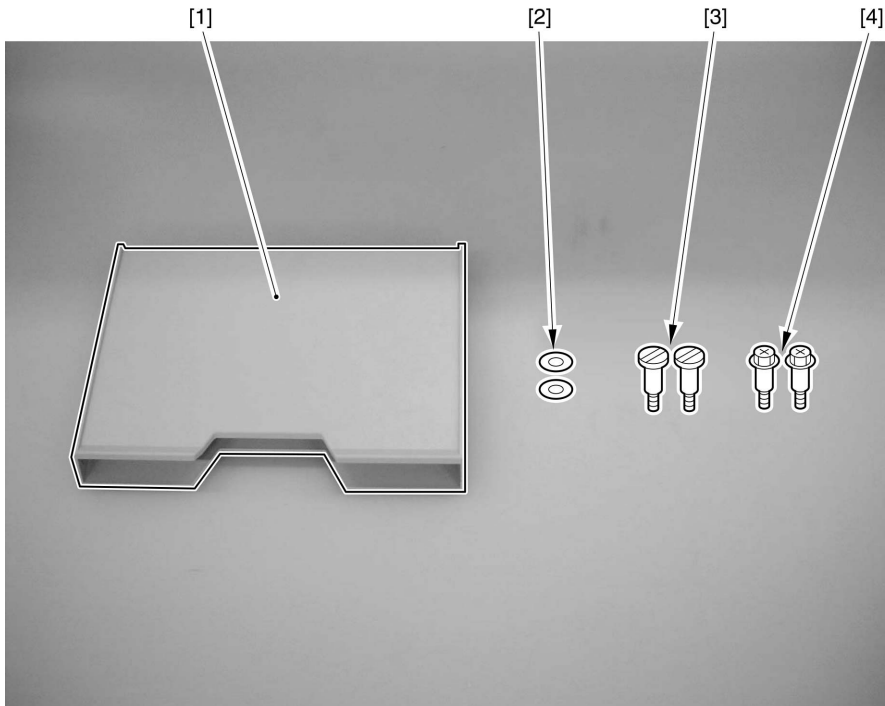
# Chapter 1   Installation Procedure

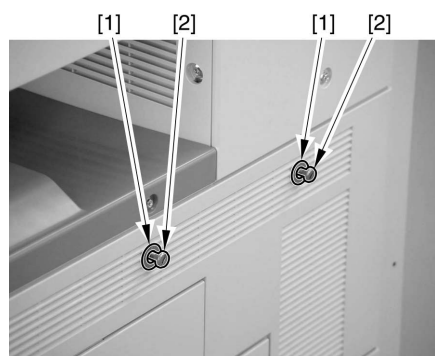
## 1.2 Installation Procedure

### 1.2.1 Installation Procedure

(iR C3200 Series)

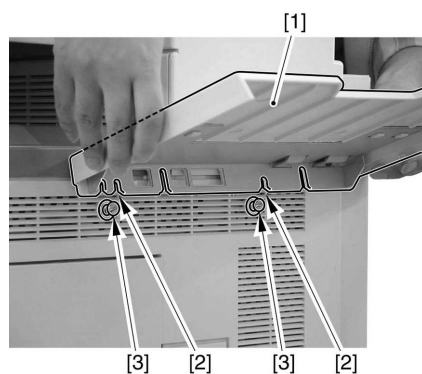
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- 1) Fit the 2 included washers [1] and 2 stepped screws [2] to the host machine's right upper cover.



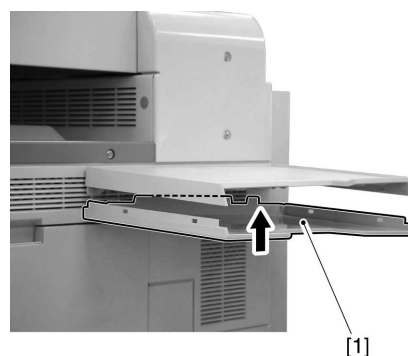

- 2) Separate the Document Tray to its upper and lower members; then, hook the slot [2] in the reinforcing plate of the Document Tray (upper) [1] to the stepped screw [3] that has previously been fitted.

- 3) Fit the lower Document Tray [1] to the upper Document Tray.

### 1.2.2 Installation Procedure

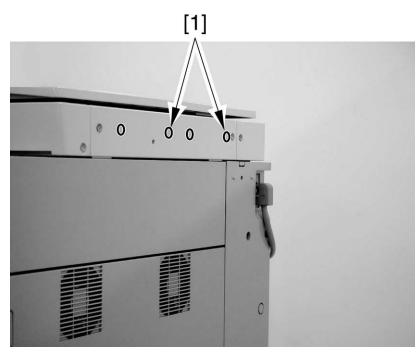
(iR C3100 Series)

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- 1) Remove the 2 dressing stickers [1] from the reader cover (right).

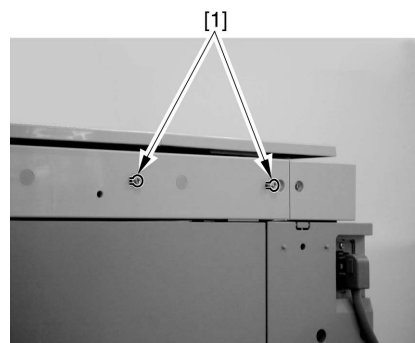
**!** Normally, attach the stickers to the rear.

If there is a control card unit, attach them to the front.



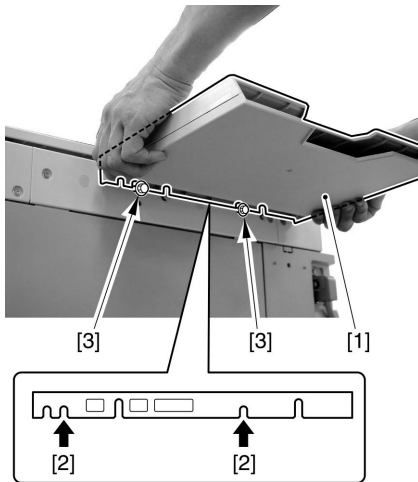

- 2) Fit the 2 included screws (6-mm dia. x 10.5; RS tightening) [1] to the reader cover (right).

- 3) Hook the slots [2] in the reinforcing plate of the Document Tray [1] on the 2 screws (6-mm dia. x 10.5; RS tightening) [3] that have previously been fitted.
