### Safety information

This instruction manual contains information and warnings that must be observed for safe operation under the conditions described.

# 2. Faults and damage

If there are any reasons to believe that the safety of the unit is affected, it must be taken out of service and precautionary steps taken to avoid further unintentional use. The safety of the unit may be affected if, e.g.:

- external damages of the housing is visible
- the unit has not been stored correctly
- the unit has suffered damage from transportation

# 3. Safety regulations

When using the Mobile telephone type 61\*\*-Ex, the appropriate safety regulations must be observed to avoid incorrect operation of the unit.

Unit not to be opened or charged in the hazardous area!

Unit must be used in the leather case in the hazardous area!

# 4. Technical safety note

## 5. Rechargeable Batteries

Batteries must be changed outside the hazardous area. Only ECOM batteries are allowed to be used. The use of batteries of other type is strictly forbidden. The Ex-Data must be observed.

#### 6. Repair

The general terms and conditions of ELEX V apply to repair work. We recommend the repair is carried out by the manufacturer, since the protective circuits must be checked after repair for safety reasons.

#### 7. Guarantee

The material and functionality of the Mobile telephone type 61\*\*-Ex is guaranteed by us for a period of one year from the date of delivery. Claims can be made under guarantee by sending the defective unit to us. We reserve the right to repair, recalibrate or replace the unit.
