

Description

Description

The Keysight Technologies Model 1182B Testmobile instrument cart provides convenient movability for your instruments. It allows you to easily view and use the instrument while seated at a work station or bench. You can tilt the instrument up to 30 degrees for viewing comfort. A nylon strap is provided to secure the instrument to the cart.

The Keysight 1182B casters have mar-resistant hard rubber tiers. The rear wheels have locking brakes. The tilt tray is designed to be used with instruments that weigh up to 150 lbs.

Initial Inspection

Inspect the shipping container for damage. If there is apparent damage to the shipping container or packaging materials, do not discard these materials until the Testmobile cart has been inspected for damage. If it has been damaged in shipment, notify the carrier and the nearest Keysight Technologies Sales/Service office.

Assembly Instructions

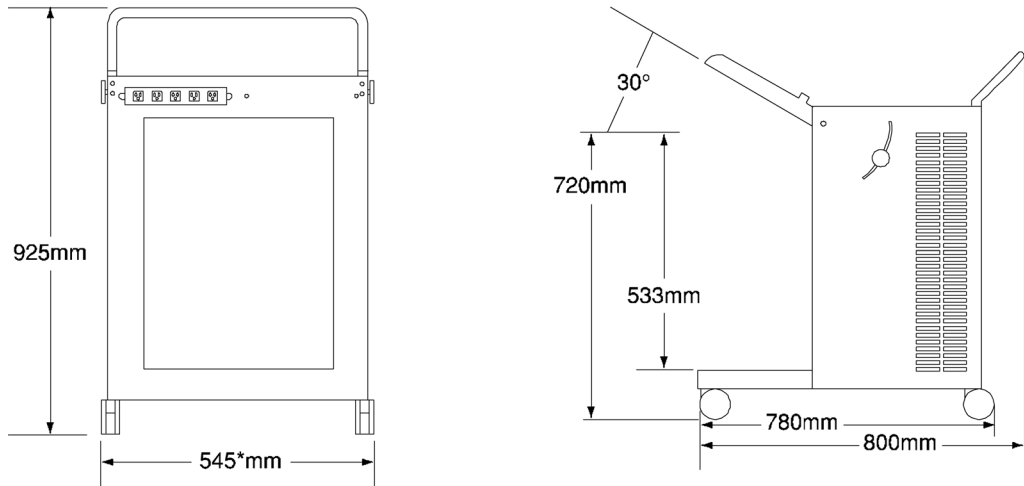


Figure 1 Testmobile cart back view and side view.

Assemble the Retaining Straps

Attach the retaining strap on the slots of the instrument tray. Thread the strap through the buckle. Attach the power strip (optional).

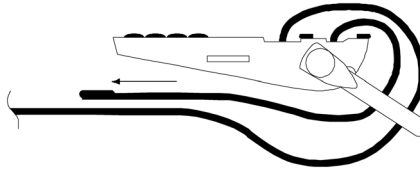


Figure 2 Inserting the strap in the fastener.

Instrument Mounting

WARNING

Observe load and center-of-gravity limits. Do not sit or stand on cart. Max load, top tray: 68.2 (150 lbs.) Max load, total: 159.1 kg (350 lbs.)

Overall width increases to 602 mm when the work surface is installed.

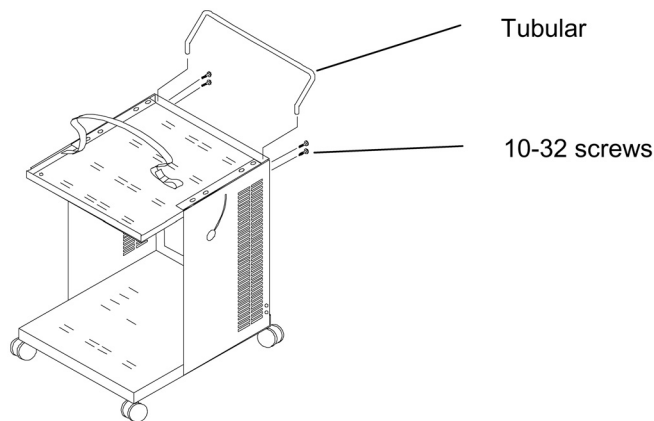


Figure 3 Testmobile cart with hold down strap in place, showing how to install the handle.

To Mount the Instrument on the Cart

Center the instrument on the tilt tray. Insert the plastic tabs that are located in front of the instrument legs in the appropriate slots of the testmobile cart.

CAUTION

Do not place the metal front legs of the instrument in an upright position. Allow the instrument to rest on all four anti-skid hard rubber feet secured with the tabs in the slots. Place the retaining strap over the top of the instrument. Hold the fastener in the hook and thread the strap through the fastener (see figure on previous page).

Operating the Tilt Tray

CAUTION

Do not force the fastener closed. If it is difficult to close the fastener, loosen the strap and allow slightly more slack. When adjusted properly, the fastener should close with little effort.

The tilt tray is adjustable from 0 to 30 degrees. This allows you to select a comfortable viewing angle. The cart is equipped with a knob on each side of the cabinet used to tighten and secure the desired angle of the tilt tray.

To Set the Tilt Tray

Loosen the knobs on each side of the cabinet. Set the desired angle. Tighten both knobs to secure the tray position.

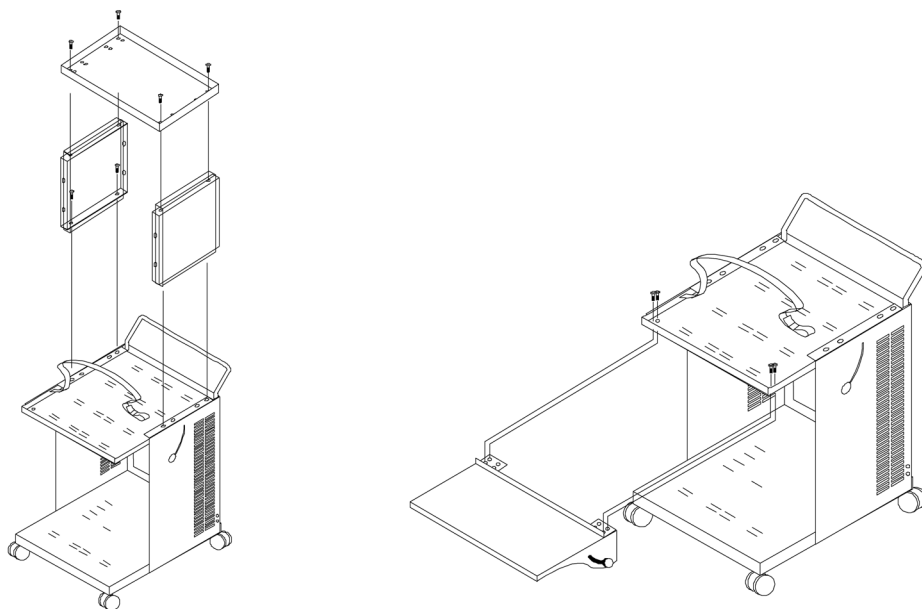


Figure 4 Left, Testmobile cart with hold down strap in place, showing optional accessories 92199B Multiple Outlet Strip and the 35181H Printer/Plotter Stand. Right, Testmobile shown with Keysight 35181K Work Surface.

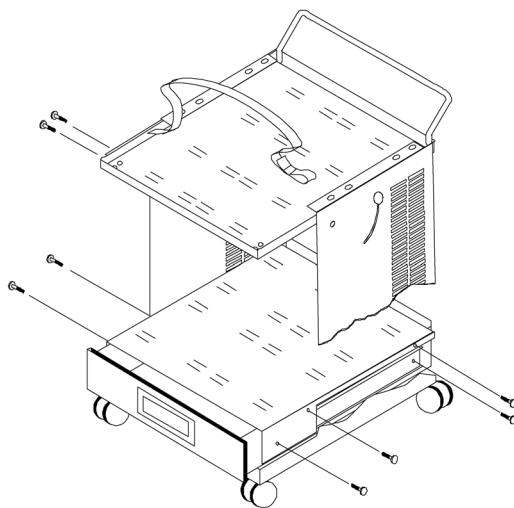


Figure 5 Keysight 35182C 89 mm (3.5 inch) drawer and storage shelf. Hardware included.
