hp-ux 11i available on DVD in December 2002

In response to the needs of our valued customers, HP is extending our HP-UX 11i Version 1.0 offering to include DVD. In December 2002, customers will have the option of receiving their quarterly updates of HP-UX 11i Version 1.0 for PA-RISC on CD-ROM or on DVD.

The delivery of HP-UX 11i Version 1.0 on DVD will provide tremendous benefits over CD-ROM.



Availability

In December 2002, HP-UX 11i Version 1.0 DVD will be available both for new purchases with new PA-RISC Server and Workstation Systems as well as standalone.

Note that HP will continue to make HP-UX 11i Version 1.0 for PA-RISC available on CD-ROM, so customers who do not have access to DVD drives can continue to use HP-UX 11i Version 1.0 CDs. However, due to significant increases in functionality and features, future enterprise release of HP-UX can be expected to be available on DVD only.

How to get a DVD media

Should you wish to switch from CD-ROM to DVD media your HP-UX 11i version 1.0 software, please contact your HP Support Sales Representative.

Your media will be changed in your support contract at your contract renewal.

Benefits to you

- ➔ The far higher capacity of the DVD format allows each of the HP-UX Operating Environments to be consolidated onto a single platter, where CD-ROM requires two platters.
- ➔ The Application CD kit consolidates 4 CD-ROMs into a single DVD.
- ➔ Aslo system installation is greatly simplified, takes far less time, and there is no more need to hunt for the correct CD that contains the layered software you need.
- ➔ Managing your media will be much simpler with DVD versus CD-ROM.
