VIEWING ONLINE HELP IN MICROSOFT INTERNET EXPLORER

If you are viewing the *standalone edition* of Fibre Channel Manager in the Microsoft Internet Explorer browser, perform the following procedure in order to view pop-up definitions in the online help system. This procedure distributes the appropriate ActiveX control file (FHPopup.ocx) from the management server to a Windows NT-based management workstation and registers the file. You should perform this procedure for each management workstation on which you want to view FC Manager online help from Microsoft Internet Explorer.

- 1. From the management workstation, open Microsoft Internet Explorer.
- 2. Enter the following URL. For *hostname*, enter the hostname of the management server. For *URLHtml*, enter the value of the URLHtml installation variable (default **fcman**). http://hostname/URLHtml/help/htmlhelp/FHPopup.ocx

The File Download window appears.

- 3. Select the $\bf Save~this~file~to~disk~option,$ then click the $\bf OK~button.$
 - The Save As window appears.
- 4. In the Save in box, select the Windows installation directory (default **Winnt**), select the **system32** directory, then click the **Save** button.
- 5. Click the **Start** button, select **Programs**, then select **Command Prompt**.
 - The Command Prompt window appears.
- 6. Enter the following command to change to the system directory.c:\> cd\winnt\system32
- 7. Enter the following command to register the FHPopup.ocx file.

Regsvr32 FHPopup.ocx

A confirmation message appears.

- 8. Click the **OK** button.
- 9. Close the Command Prompt window.
