Situation:

The E5070A and E5071A's A1 source board E5071-6x501, E5071-6x551, and E5071-6x561 module had high-failure rate component parts problem, thus it was re-designed to improve its reliability as E5071-6x571.

When the high-failure rate part has defective, the unit cannot output correct power level source or local signal, between 1.3 GHz and 2.1 GHz frequency range.

Typical symptoms are as the followings:

- The trace shows spike at 1.3 GHz or 2.1 GHz at the preset situation.
- The trace between 1.3 GHz to 2.1 GHz is more noisy than other frequency ranges.
- The power level of 1.3 GHz to 2.1 GHz is lower than other frequency ranges.
- Internal test of A1 ALC shows fail at SOP (f=1.3G) or LOP (f=1.3G) as Figure 2.

Above symptoms tend to appear after 30-minute heat run.




Figure 1. Trace shows noise around 1.3 GHz to 2.1 GHz at preset setting.




Figure 2. A1 ALC in Internal test has failure at SOP (f=1.3G) or LOP (f=1.3G)

And the latest A1 board (E5071-66571, E5071-69571) requires firmware version Rev.A.3.62 or later. If customer unit's firmware version is less than Rev.A.3.60, it should be updated by changing the operating system.

With Rev A.03.60 or below version firmware, an error message "Power on test fail (A1 not found)" is shown at lower left part on a display at power on. If the power-on test limit file is not installed, any of messages "Power on test failed (A1 DC-bus, 0x00000010)", "Power on test failed (A1 DC-bus, 0x00000020)", or "Power on test failed (A1 DC-bus, 0x00000030)" is shown at power on.

At last, attach the last page of this note to the unit to inform the customer that the HDD is changed and a firmware version is updated.
