Installation Procedure for the Upgrade Kit

Installation Requirements

- The network analyzer must be in proper working condition prior to installing this option. Any necessary repairs must be made before proceeding with this installation.
- This installation does not require removal of the analyzer's protective outer covers.
- The analyzer must be powered up and operating to perform this installation. The Network Analyzer program must be running.
- This installation requires that a keyboard and a mouse be connected to the network analyzer.

Verify the Serial and Option Numbers

Refer to the License Key Certificate:

• Verify that the analyzer's model and serial numbers match those on the certificate.

If the model number, serial number, or option number do not match those on your License Key Certificate, you will not be able to install the option. If this is the case, contact Agilent for assistance. Refer to "Contacting Agilent" on page 3.

Enable the Option

- 1. On the analyzer's **System** menu, point to **Service**, and then click **Option Enable**.
- 2. In the **Select Desired Option** list, click the option listed on your License Key Certificate. For example, click **080 Frequency Offset**.
- 3. Using the keyboard, enter the keyword in the box provided. The keyword is printed on the License Key Certificate. Enter this keyword *exactly* as it is printed on the certificate.
- 4. Click Enable.
- 5. Click **Yes** in answer to the displayed question in the **Restart Analyzer?** box.
- 6. When the installation is complete, click **Exit**.

Verify that the Option is Enabled

Once the analyzer has restarted and the Network Analyzer program is again running:

- 7. On the analyzer's **Help** menu, click **About Network Analyzer**.
- 8. Verify that the option you enabled is listed after "Options:" in the display. Click **OK**.
