Situation:

The PAL, A16U114, was incorrectly programmed for the range of serial numbers described above. The parts appear to operate correctly but the longer term reliability may be degraded.

Solution/Action:

It is recommended that A16U114 (08590-80200) is replaced when any failure is reported on the range of spectrum analyzers described above. The part should be changed even for failures which appear unrelated to the PAL operation. The part will only require to be changed once because all incorrectly programmed parts have been purged from stock.

It should not be necessary to remove the A16 processor assembly from the instrument, to replace the PAL, U114. The PAL device is in a socket and is located beside the ROM, U7.
