- ___ 2. Check all the items and count parts listed on the BM(s) to be used to determine whether all parts were received.

Replace the V35 card with a new one and replace the part number label on the ARC.

9.0 Safety

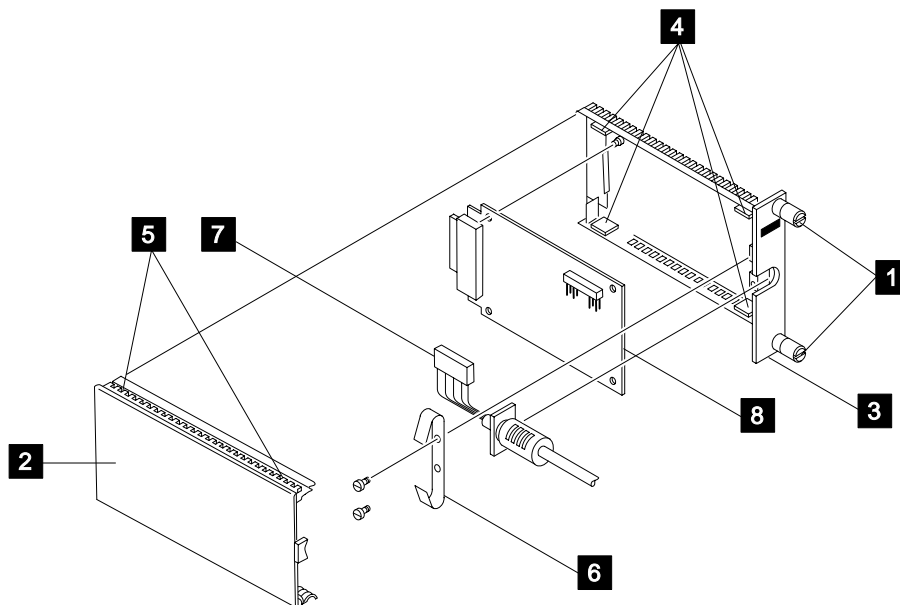
Review the **Safety Notices** and the **Safety Inspection Procedures** located at the beginning of the 3745 *Maintenance Information Procedures (MIP)* manual (SY33-2054).

10.0 Details of Installation

When the ARCs to be unplugged are identified, ask the customer to deactivate the line(s) of the associated ARCs.

10.1 Hardware Exchange

Warning: Follow existing ESD procedures when handling logic parts.



- ___ 1. Unfasten the two front captive screws **1**.
- ___ 2. Remove the ARC from the LCB.
- ___ **Note:** The top cover **2** and the bottom cover **3** are clipped together with four internal latches **4**.
- ___ 3. In the second hole **5**, on each side of the top cover **2** insert a screwdriver pushing on the four internal latches **4**. Remove the top cover.
- ___ 4. Remove the spring **6** (two screws).
- ___ 5. Unplug the connector **7** from the card **8**.
- ___ 6. Remove the card from the bottom cover.
- ___ 7. Install the new card coming with the BM.
- ___ 8. Plug the connector **7** in the new card **8**.
- ___ 9. Reinstall the spring **6** (two screws).

- ___ 10. Clip the covers together. Place the new preprinted part number label over the existing label located on the side of the ARC.
- ___ 11. Reinstall the ARC in the LCB.
- ___ 12. Ask the customer to reactivate the line(s).

Important note: The old cards must be returned to IBM.
