## **Safety precaution**

↑ CAUTION Burrs formed during molding may be left over on some parts of the chassis. Therefore, pay attention to such burrs in the case of preforming repair of this system.

### **Disassembly method**

#### ■ Removing the front net (See Fig.1)

 Remove the front net from the six holders that are fixing the front net.

### ■ Removing the tweeter (See Fig.2&3)


- Removing the front net.
- Remove the three screws A attaching the tweeter using a hexagon wrench.
- 2. Remove the speaker cord (Yellow, Black).

### ■ Removing the woofer (See Fig.2&4)

- \* Removing the front net.
- 1. Remove the eight screws **B** on both sides of the woofer using a hexagon wrench.
- 2. Remove the speaker cord (Red, Black) on both sides of the woofer.


## Removing the net walk assembly (See Fig.5)

- Removing the front net.
- Removing the tweeter.
- Removing the woofer of right side.
- Remove the sound absorbent material inside of the speaker box.
- 2. Remove the four screws **C** attaching the net walk assembly.
- 3. Lift the net walk assembly.



#### Caution

Care should be taken not to turn the speaker face down. Turning the speaker face down may damage the edges of the speaker.
