Using the KCA-RC800AV to control the LZ-700W and P907

The illustration below shows how a specially-programmed KCA-RC800AV will control the LZ-700W and the P907.

P907: Increases the volume
LZ-700W: Increases the volume of the internal speaker)

Both: Tunes to the next lower channel

Both: Tunes to the next higher channel

P907: Decreases the volume
LZ-700W: Decreases the volume of the internal speaker)

LZ-700W: Switches the Channel Selection Mode between:
AUTO: Automatic Tuning
PR-S: Preset Tuning
MANU: Manual Tuning

P907: Switches the Channel Selection Mode between AUTO 1, AUTO 2, and MANUAL

LZ-700W: Changes the internal speaker output independent of the video signal being shown. Audio is switched between:
NOR: Normal
TV: Television
NAV: Navigation
VD1: Video 1*
VD2: Video 2*

* Depends on Setup screen settings

LZ-700W: Switches the Screen Mode between NORMAL, FULL and ZOOM
P907: Switches the Screen Mode between NORMAL, FULL, JUST, and ZOOM

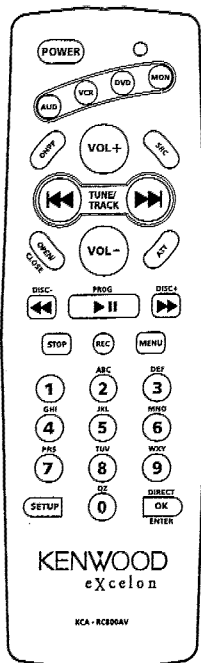
LZ-700W: Changes the video display between:
TV: Television
NAV: Navigation
VD1: Video 1*
VD2: Video 2*

* Depends on Setup screen settings

LZ-700W: Toggles the TV band between TV1 and TV2
P907: Switches the Video input between TV1, TV2, VD1 and VD2. When TUNER is selected, switches between FM1, FM2 and FM3.

USER GUIDE

OVERVIEW

The Kenwood Excelon KCA-RC800AV Universal Remote Control is designed to control up to four components, including selected Kenwood mobile entertainment receivers. For your convenience, it has been set up at the factory to control an RCA TV monitor, an RCA DVD player, a Toshiba VCR, and a Kenwood mobile receiver unit.

The KCA-RC800AV requires four fresh AAA alkaline batteries (not included) and easy programming if you want to control components other than those set by default.

NOTE: The audio mode (AUD) cannot be reprogrammed. It is always set for Kenwood mobile electronic units.

For best results, please read and perform all instructions listed here. Also, keep these instructions for future reference.

WARNING: AVOID LEAVING THE REMOTE CONTROL IN A SPOT EXPOSED TO DIRECT SUNLIGHT.

INSTALLING BATTERIES

1. On the KCA-RC800AV's back, pull back the battery cover and remove it.
2. Obtain four (4) fully-charged AAA alkaline batteries. Match the + and - marks on the batteries to the + and - marks in the battery case, then insert batteries.
3. Push the battery cover back into place.
4. Test the KCA-RC800AV by pressing **POWER** and any mode key (i.e., **AUD, VCR, DVD, or MON**). If the batteries are inserted correctly, the indicator LED will blink after your selection.

NOTE: When batteries are low, the unit will cease to operate. Replacing the batteries will restore full functionality and will not require you to reprogram your KCA-RC800AV.

FEATURES AND FUNCTIONS

After the KCA-RC800AV has been programmed, aim the unit at a component you want to control and press the appropriate mode key (i.e., **MON, DVD, VCR, or AUD**).

After a mode key is pressed, the indicator LED will blink, confirming your choice. Then use the other keys to perform desired actions as explained in the following key chart.

NOTE: The selected mode will remain active until you press another mode key.

- The indicator LED (red light) blinks to show that the remote control is working and is sending signals.
- AUD VCR DVD MON** Press **AUD, VCR, DVD, or MON (TV)** once to select a mobile electronic component you want to control.
- POWER** Press **POWER** once to turn ON or OFF the selected component.
- DNPP** Press **DNPP** once to activate Disc Name Preset Play (DNPP). See your receiver's manual for further details.

- SRC** Each time you press **SRC**, the receiver switches among its available modes.
- VOL+** Use **VOL + (or VOL -)** to raise (or lower) the volume of the audio component.
- VOL-**
- TUNE/TRACK** In the **MON or VCR** mode, use the **▶▶** (or **◀◀**) key to select next higher (or lower) channel.

- In the **AUD or DVD** mode, use these keys to select the next higher (or lower) track.
- OPEN/CLOSE** Press **OPEN/CLOSE** once to open or close the CD or DVD tray.
- ATT** Press **ATT** once to turn down the volume quickly. Press it again to restore the volume to its original level.

- DISC- DISC+ STOP REC** Use **▶▶** (Play/Pause), **STOP**, **◀◀** (Rewind), and **▶▶** (Fast Forward) keys to control a selected component.

- In the **AUD** mode, use these keys (**PROG, DISC-**, and **DISC+**) to control a CD changer.
- In the **VCR** mode, press **REC** once to record a video program.

- 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 0** Use the keypad (**0 ~ 9**) to directly select channel or track numbers.
- When keying-in titles, press an alphabet key (e.g., **ABC**) one to three times for the desired letter. Use the **▶▶** (or **◀◀**) key to move cursor to the next (or previous) letter.
- SETUP** Press **SETUP** to start programming mode.

- MENU** Use **MENU** to display the components (i.e., **AUD, VCR, DVD, or MON**) main menu.
- DIRECT OK ENTER** Depending on the component being controlled (i.e., **AUD, VCR, DVD, or MON**), use **OK/ENTER/DIRECT** to select menu options or enter channel/track numbers or titles.

PROGRAMMING TV CONTROL

1. Turn on the TV.
2. On the KCA-RC800AV, press the **MON** key once.
3. Locate the code for your TV in *Setup Codes for TVs* below. Brands are listed in alphabetical order with the most popular codes listed first.
4. Press and hold **SETUP** (at least 3 seconds) until the indicator LED blinks twice. Then release **SETUP**.
5. Enter the first four-digit code for your TV. The indicator LED will blink once with each digit entry. Once the entire code is entered, the indicator LED will blink twice to confirm it is a valid code.
- NOTE: If you enter an invalid code, the indicator LED will display one long blink. In that case, repeat steps 2 through 5 with a valid code.*
6. Aim the KCA-RC800AV at your TV and press **POWER** once. The TV should turn off. If it does not respond, repeat steps 2-5, trying each code listed for your brand until you find one that works. If it still does not work with the KCA-RC800AV, try searching for the code (see *Searching For Your Code* on the back side).
7. Write your TV code in the boxes below for future reference.

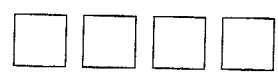

5. Enter the first four-digit code for your VCR. The indicator LED will blink once with each digit entry. Once the entire code is entered, the indicator LED will blink twice to confirm it is a valid code.

NOTE: If you enter an invalid code, the indicator LED will display one long blink. In that case, repeat steps 2 through 5 with a valid code.

6. Aim the KCA-RC800AV at your VCR and press **POWER** once. Your VCR should turn off. If your VCR remote control does not have a **POWER** key, press **PLAY**. If it does not respond, repeat steps 2-5, trying each code listed for your brand until you find the one that operates your VCR. If your VCR still does not work with the KCA-RC800AV, try searching for the code (see *Searching For Your Code* on the back side).

7. Write your VCR code in the boxes below for future reference.



*NOTE: Remember, to operate your VCR using the KCA-RC800AV, press **VCR** first.*

PROGRAMMING VCR CONTROL

1. Turn on your VCR and insert a video cassette.
2. On the KCA-RC800AV, press the **VCR** key once.
3. Locate your VCR brand in the *Setup Codes For VCRs* below. Brands are listed in alphabetical order with the most popular codes listed first.
4. Press and hold **SETUP** (at least 3 seconds) until the indicator LED blinks twice. Then release **SETUP**.

PROGRAMMING DVD PLAYER CONTROL

1. Turn on your DVD player and insert a disc.
2. On the KCA-RC800AV, press the **DVD** key once.
3. Locate your DVD player brand in the *Setup Codes For DVD Players* on the back side. Brands are listed in alphabetical order with the most popular codes listed first.
4. Press and hold **SETUP** (at least 3 seconds) until the indicator LED blinks twice. Then release **SETUP**.
5. Enter the first four-digit code for your DVD player. The indicator LED will blink once with each digit entry. Once the entire code is entered, the indicator LED will blink twice to confirm it is a valid code.

NOTE: If you enter an invalid code, the indicator LED will display one long blink. In that case, repeat steps 2 through 5 with a valid code.

6. Aim the KCA-RC800AV at your DVD player and press **POWER** once. Your unit should turn off. If your DVD remote control does not have a **POWER** key, press **PLAY**. If it does not respond, repeat steps 2-5, trying each code listed for your brand until you find the one that operates your DVD player. If it still does not work with the KCA-RC800AV, try searching for the code (see *Searching For Your Code* on the back side).
7. Write the DVD player code in the boxes below for future reference.

SEARCHING FOR YOUR CODE

If your TV, VCR, or DVD Player does not respond to the KCA-RC800AV after trying all of the codes listed for your brand, or if your brand is not listed at all, try searching for your code.

For example, after trying all of the codes for your TV, you still cannot get the KCA-RC800AV to operate your TV, then:

1. Turn on your TV.
2. On the KCA-RC800AV, press and release the **MON** key.
3. Press and hold **SETUP** (at least 3 seconds) until the indicator LED blinks twice. Then release **SETUP**.
4. Enter **9 - 9 - 1**. The indicator LED will blink twice.
5. Aim the KCA-RC800AV at the TV and slowly alternate between pressing **POWER** and **MON**. Stop when the TV turns off – a code that works has been found.

NOTE: In the search mode, the KCA-RC800AV will send IR codes from its library to the selected component, starting with the most popular codes first.

6. Press and release the **SETUP** key to lock in the code.
7. To search for the codes of your other components, repeat steps 1 through 6, but substitute the appropriate device key (i.e., **VCR**, or **DVD**) for the component you are searching for.

CHECKING THE CODES

If you have set up the KCA-RC800AV using the *Searching For Your Code* procedure, you can use the following instructions to find out what code is operating your equipment:

For example, to find out which code is operating your TV:

1. Turn on your TV.
2. On the KCA-RC800AV, press the **MON** key once.
3. Press and hold **SETUP** (at least 3 seconds) until the indicator LED blinks twice. Then release **SETUP**.
4. Press **9 - 9 - 0**. The indicator LED will blink twice.
5. To view the code for the first digit, press and release **1**. Count the number of blinks (e.g., 3 blinks = 3) and write down the number in the leftmost box below.

NOTE: The indicator LED will not blink if the code digit is a "0".

6. Repeat step 5 three more times for each successive digit by pressing and releasing **2, 3**, and then **4**. Finish writing down the code in the boxes above.
7. To check for the codes of your other components, repeat steps 1 through 6, only substitute the appropriate device key (i.e., **VCR**, or **DVD**) for the component you are checking. Write down the codes in the boxes below.

LEARNING FUNCTIONS

The KCA-RC800AV has the capability of learning functions that are taught by your original remote control. For best learning results, choose a location where area light is low (e.g., indoors, away from direct sunlight or lamps) and perform the following steps:

1. On the KCA-RC800AV, press a desired mode key once (i.e., **MON**, **DVD**, or **VCR**).
- NOTE: Learning is not available in the **AUD** mode.*
2. Press and hold **SETUP** (at least 3 seconds) until the indicator LED blinks twice. Then release **SETUP**.
 3. Press **9 - 7 - 5**. The indicator LED will again blink twice.
 4. On the KCA-RC800AV, press the key where you want the feature to be learned. The indicator LED will blink rapidly.

5. Place the KCA-RC800AV and the original remote control head-to-head, and no more than 2 inches apart.
 6. On the original remote control, press and hold down the key to be taught. On the KCA-RC800AV, the indicator LED will turn off.
 7. Continue pressing the key to be taught until the indicator LED on the KCA-RC800AV blinks twice.
- NOTE: If the KCA-RC800AV indicator LED blinks one long blink, learning has failed. Try step 5 through 7 again.*

8. Repeat step 4 through 7 for additional keys you want learned.
9. To exit the learning mode, press and hold **SETUP** until the indicator LED blinks twice. Then release **SETUP**.

Deleting A Learned Function:

1. On the KCA-RC800AV, press a desired mode key once (i.e., **MON**, **DVD**, or **VCR**).

*NOTE: Learning is not available in the **AUD** mode.*

2. Press and hold **SETUP** (at least 3 seconds) until the indicator LED blinks twice. Then release **SETUP**.
3. Press **9 - 7 - 6**. The indicator LED will again blink twice.
4. Press the key you want clear twice.

TROUBLESHOOTING

PROBLEM: Indicator LED does not blink when you press a key.

SOLUTION: Replace the batteries with four (4) new AAA alkaline batteries.

PROBLEM: Indicator LED blinks when you press a key, but the component does not respond.

SOLUTION: Make sure you are aiming the KCA-RC800AV at the component and that you are within 15 feet of the component you are trying to control.

PROBLEM: KCA-RC800AV does not control entertainment components or commands are not working properly.

SOLUTION: Try all listed codes for the component brand being set up. Make sure all components can be operated with an infrared remote control.

PROBLEM: Changing channels does not work properly.

SOLUTION: If the original remote control required pressing ENTER to change channels, press **ENTER** on the KCA-RC800AV after entering the channel number.

PROBLEM: LED blinks one long blink during learning.

SOLUTION: Bad learning capture. Try learning sequence again.

Memory full. Try deleting another learned function; repeat learning sequence again.

Cannot learn function in audio (**AUD**) mode.

PROBLEM: LED blinks one long blink during programming, searching codes, or checking codes.

SOLUTION: Invalid entry. Try entering data again.
