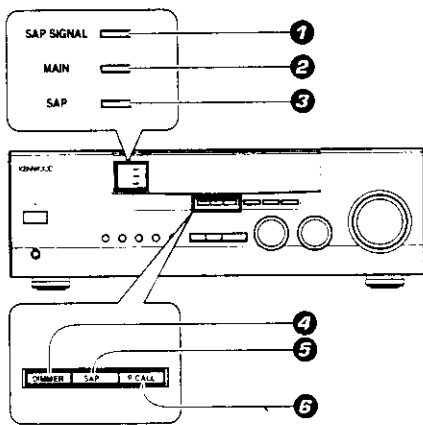
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In addition to FM and AM broadcasts, the VR-257 is also capable of receiving the audio portion of cable TV broadcasts via cable box. This instruction manual explains the operating procedures for receiving the audio portion of TV broadcasts using the VR-257.

Some cable TV broadcasts include the SAP (Second Audio Program) service. In such cases, you can use the VR-257 to enjoy multiplex audio, etc., during SAP broadcasts.

For information on standard operating procedures, such as receiving standard radio broadcasts, station presets, etc., refer to the separate receiver instruction manual.

Names and function of parts



1 SAP SIGNAL indicator

Lights when a SAP input signal is being received by the VR-257. You may use the SAP function when this indicator is lit.

2 MAIN indicator

Lights when the main broadcast (normal stereo broadcast, etc.) has been selected and is being received.

3 SAP indicator

Lights when the SAP signal has been selected and is being received.

4 DIMMER key

Use to adjust the brightness of the display.

5 SAP key

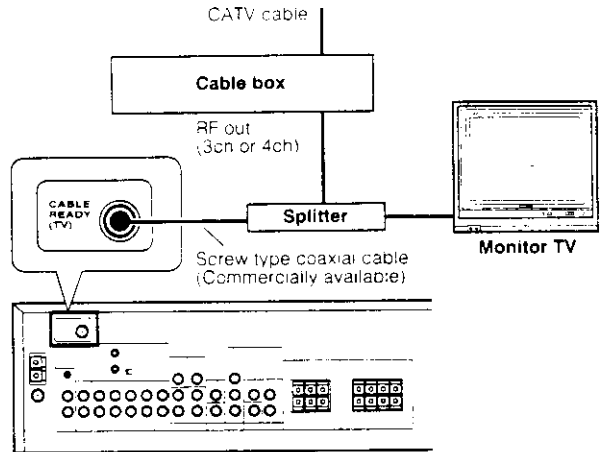
Use to switch SAP broadcasts on or off.

6 P.CALL key

Use to call up previously registered radio stations.

• Refer to the separate receiver instruction manual for information on the other keys and knobs.

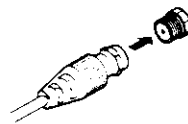
Connecting antenna for CATV reception



Connections to the CABLE READY jack

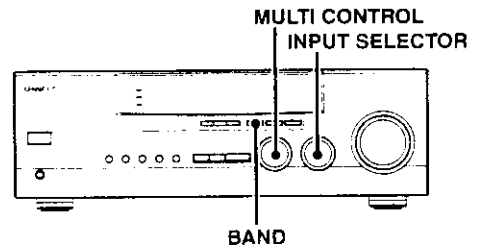
1 While inserting the connector...

2 Turn the screw to tighten.



• In order to make connections to a cable antenna, the necessary equipment (in addition to the VR-257) and cable must be obtained. Contact a dealer near you for details.

Preparing to receive CATV broadcasts



1 Turn on the power to the related components.

2 Use the input selector to select the tuner.

3 Use the **BAND** key to select TV.

Each press switches the band as follows:

- 1 TV
- 2 FM
- 3 AM

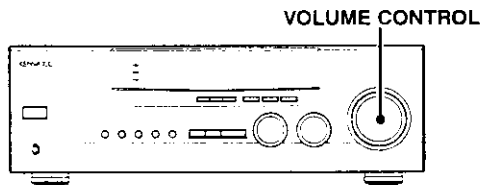
- The currently selected listening mode is stored in memory and used in common for all bands.

4 Use the **MULTI CONTROL** knob to select the channel setting used for output from the cable box connected to the VR-257.

- 1 TV 3ch
- 2 TV 4ch

- Check the RF output setting of the cable box and set the channel mode of the VR-257 to match it. There is no need to change the channel setting once it has been set to match that of the cable box. The cable box is then used to select specific channel broadcasts.

Enjoying CATV broadcasts



1 Complete the preparations for receiving broadcasts.

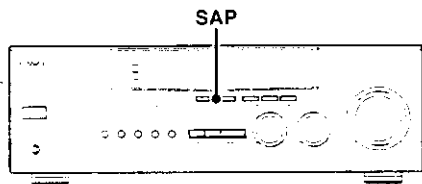
2 Use the cable box to select the desired channel.

- Adjust the volume control of the cable box to the maximum setting.

3 Use the **VOLUME CONTROL (VOLUME)** to adjust the volume.

Enjoying SAP broadcasts

When a broadcast featuring the SAP (Second Audio Program) service is being received, you can enjoy the benefits this format provides, such as bilingual soundtracks, using the VR-257.



1 Tune in a CATV channel broadcast for which the **SAP SIGNAL** indicator lights.

- The SAP (Second Audio Program) service is a program service provided along with the main program being received. For details, consult your SAP program guide or receiver manual.

2 Press the **SAP** key to select the desired mode.

Each press switches the mode as follows:

- 1 **MAIN** indicator lit (normal stereo broadcasts, etc.)
- 2 **SAP** indicator lit (monaural broadcasts such as bilingual soundtracks, etc.)

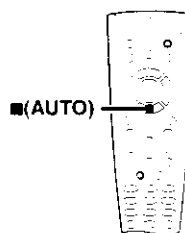
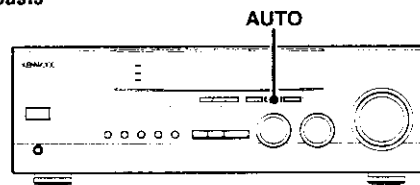
- The type of SAP service provided differs depending on the TV station.
- It is not possible to change the SAP mode setting when no SAP broadcast is being received.

The output changes as shown below depending on the type of audio signal and the mode selected.

Items in parentheses refer to the indicator that is lit.

Using the **AUTO SOUND** mode when receiving TV broadcasts



When TV is selected as the reception band, the VR-257's **AUTO** key functions to toggle the **AUTO SOUND** mode on and off.

When **AUTO SOUND** is turned on (**AUTO SOUND** indicator lit), the listening mode is switched automatically to match the tuner's input signal and prevent an inappropriate mode from being selected. If you wish to select the listening mode manually, press the **AUTO** key to make the **AUTO SOUND** indicator go off and then select the listening mode.

Example: If you are listening to a stereo broadcast using the **MAIN** setting and in the **Dynamic Pro Logic** mode, and then you switch to the **SAP** mode, the **AUTO SOUND** function will automatically turn off **Dynamic Pro Logic**. This is because the **SAP** mode produces a monaural signal, and the **Dynamic Pro Logic** mode would therefore not produce any noticeable effect.

- Press the **SETUP** key to enter the **AUTO SOUND** mode.
