Digital Camera Users



Transfer photos from your digital camera to your computer.

*Refer to your camera's instructions to get started



Access "You've Got Pictures"

*Found on AOL's Welcome page or go to AOL Keyword: Pictures



Upload to "You've Got Pictures"

*Click on the Upload Pictures button and now you're ready to have some fun

Film Camera Users



Drop off a roll of film at a participating retailer and check the AOL box on the film processing envelope. Make sure to provide your AOL screen name.



Pick up your prints and negatives at your retailer as usual. Then sign onto AOL and click the new "You've Got Pictures" button on the Welcome Screen to view your pictures, or go to AOL Keyword: Pictures.



Enjoy your pictures! Once your pictures are online, you can instantly email them to friends and family on AOL or the internet, organize your photos into

albums, invite friends to view your albums, order gifts and prints, and MORE!
