

# INSTALLATION

### BATTERY INSTALLATION:

Open the battery compartment by sliding it downward and lifting it up. Insert two (2) "AAA" size batteries (not included) following the polarity diagram. Slide the battery compartment back in place.



### BATTERY PRECAUTIONS

Follow these precautions when using batteries in this device:


- 1. Use only the size and type of batteries specified.
- 2. Be sure to follow the correct polarity when installing the batteries as indicated next to the battery compartment. Reversed batteries may cause damage to the device.
- Do not mix different types of batteries together (e.g. Alkaline, rechargeable and Carbonzinc) or old batteries with fresh ones.
- If the device is not to be used for a long period of time, remove the batteries to prevent damage or injury from possible battery leakage.
- Do not try to recharge batteries not intended to be recharged; they can overheat and rupture. (Follow battery manufacturer's directions.)

### IMPORTANT NOTE WHEN CHANGING BATTERIES:

Make sure to change the batteries within 30 seconds, otherwise the time and memory may be lost.




# OPERATION

### EARBUDS:

Included with this unit are earbuds. Make sure the volume is set to minimum and insert the earbud plug into the earbud jack on the side of the unit. Place the earbuds into your left and right ears, corresponding to the "L" and "R" mark on each earbud.


# TO TURN THE UNIT ON HOLD Image: Additional system of the power button on the top of the unit. Image: Additional system of the display. This is useful if listening while the unit is in your pocket, etc. Slide the HOLD switch to the OSP position to activate all buttons again.

### TO LISTEN TO THE RADIO




#### Antennas

### **RECALLING THE PRESETS**



Repeat step 1 on the previous page. Press the PRESET button repeatedly until the desired memory number appears on the display.

### TO SET OR RESET THE ACTUAL TIME



While the power is off, press the MEMORY/Clock Set button; the time will blink.



Press and hold the TUNE Down button • to set the present hour and then press and hold the TUNE Up button • to set the present minute. Make sure the correct AM/PM indicator is lit. Press the MEMORY/ Clock Set button • to confirm the setting.
