
Fig 1 How to remove B cover.....	4

## Disassembly instructions

### Remove B-cover

- Turn the phone upside down, avoid making scratch marks on the LCD window.'
- Press the locking latch, slide the cover and lift it off.

Figure 1: How to remove B cover




### Remove battery and SIM card

Press the two catches in opposite directions and remove the battery.

Slide the SIM card (if inserted) out of its slot.


Figure 2: How to remove battery and SIM



### Remove front cover (A cover)

Open the two screws holding the A cover.

Then turn the phone over and remove the A cover.

First pry open the corners as indicated by arrows:


Figure 4: How to remove A cover



### Remove keys

Lift out the left (1) and right (2) qwerty key mats and the keymat under the display (3).

### Remove light guide

Remove the screws holding the light guide and one holding the LCD.

Lift off the light guide.


Figure 6: How to remove light guide



### Remove UIF module

Remove the two screws holding the UIF module and lift off the module.


Figure 7: How to remove UIF module



## Remove CMT module


Remove the two screws holding the CMT module.

Lift the CMT module out of the B cover.

Figure 9: CMT module separated from the B cover




### Remove spacer frame

Open the four screws holding the spacer frame.

Now the CMT PWB can be lifted off from its frame.

## Reassembly

Reassembly is carried out in reversed order compared with disassembly.

The screw torque is 0.17Nm (at 600rpm).

Some details of the reassembly are described on the following pages.

### Side keys assembly


Figure 11: Side keys assembly



Note: The keys are an integral part of the B cover and cannot be removed, the figure above is for reference only.

### Front cover reassembly

When assembling the keys and the front cover, it is advisable to do as follows:

- Place the keymats in the front cover which is upside down.
- Then place the entire phone assembly in the front cover from above.
