# Television Location


# AUTO POWER ON FEATURE

This Monitor has an Auto Power On feature which automatically turns the unit ON when AC power is supplied. This feature initiates the Monitor to turn On automatically when using it with other equipment to a main power switch. (Such as: AC power strip or when plugged directly into the back of another video equipment.) Once the initial power has been supplied and the Monitor turns ON, the POWER switch located on the front of the Monitor may be used to turn the Monitor OFF and ON as desired.



## **Procedure**

- Press Action button.
- Press CH ▲/▼ and VOL ◄/▶ buttons to highlight the Set-up Icon. –
- Press Action button to display Set-up sub menu.



- Press ▼ button to highlight AUTO POWER ON.
- Press ◄/▶ button to select ON or OFF.
- Press ACTION button twice to exit.

To confirm if the Control Panel Lock feature is activated, press any button other than the POWER button (the Power button is never disabled).
