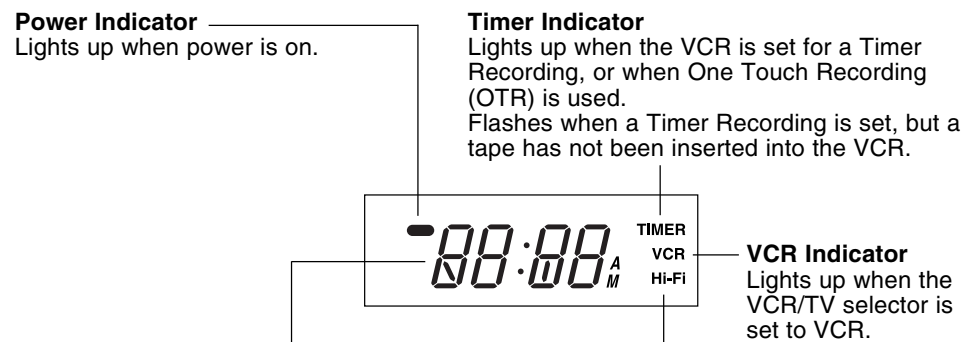

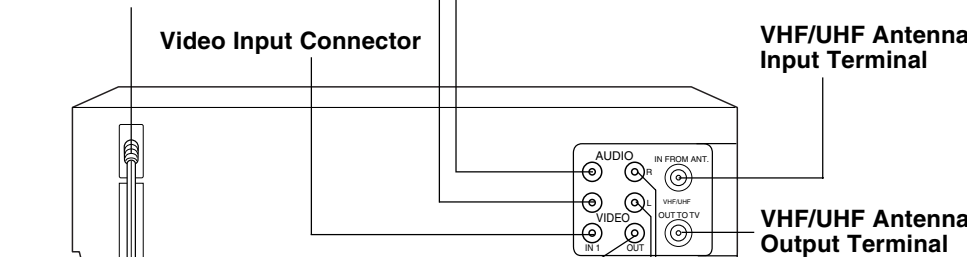
Multi Function Display



Clock/ Status/ Channel/ Speed Display
Displays the current time. Briefly displays VCR status when a function button is pressed.
Briefly displays the channel number, or "L1" or "L2" when a channel or line input is selected.
Briefly displays the recording speed when SPEED is pressed.

AC Power Plug
While plugged into an AC outlet, the VCR consumes 3.0 W (PV-V4522) [2.5 W (PV-V4022)] of electrical power in off condition.

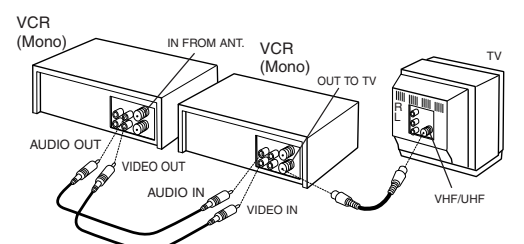

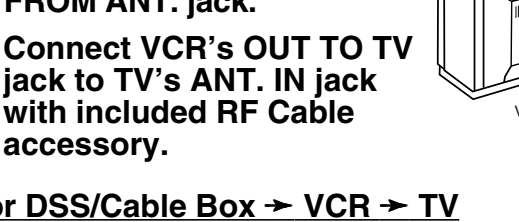

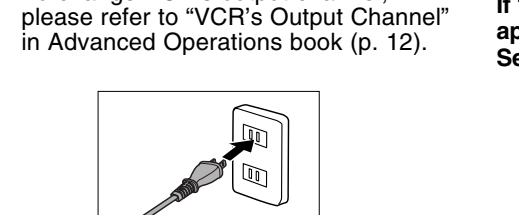
