128-bit encryption unit for analog, ISDN and GSM modems

Automatic encryption of modem links

The unit, about as big as a cigarette pack, is simply connected between the COM port of a PC or notebook and its modem. It automatically encrypts all data to be transmitted. Due to its small size, wide application range and simple use, SITMinisafe is ideal for protecting insecure links like telephone lines or mobile modem links to a LAN as in teleworking.

Data transmission via modem on telephone lines or in mobile-radio networks is now an everyday thing. Corporate networks are generally protected in numerous ways, but modem links through public networks, like those used for teleworking or remote maintenance, are often neglected. The result is damage caused by spying, manipulation or unauthorized access. SITMinisafe permits secure, encrypted data transfer via modem.

The unit, about the size of a cigarette pack, is easily installed between the COM interface of a PC or notebook and its modem. Data are securely transmitted with the aid of a 128-bit key that protects them against unauthorized intruders. Different algorithms are available for encryption. The entire control, initialization and key management of SITMinisafe are performed from a terminal program that is completely independent of the user platform and operating system. The encryption mode forces the setup of an encrypted link or aborts connection if the key is incorrect or missing. Set parameters, operating mode and status of the unit are displayed on an integrated LCD.
