SAILOR 33 Fleet+ Installation Check List



The check list is an aid in securing that all necessary settings have been made following the installation of SAILOR 33 Fleet+.

References are made to the SAILOR 33 Fleet+ **Getting Started** manual and the **User Guide** on the enclosed CD.

Configuration from PC is done by downloading the SAILOR vtLite program from the CD, see **Getting Started** > Installing the PC program.

Check that all grounding conditions are according to the installation appendix in Getting Started!

Antenna Unit

When placing the antenna avoid obstructions and interference.

Below Deck Equipment

Ensure a free space around the BDU of at least 10 cm for adequate cooling, and to allow removal of the unit.
