SUBJECT: Correctly setting the Lamp Out Control after changing the Digital PCB.

SYMPTOM- Screen is too dark or too bright.


BACKGROUND: After changing the Digital PCB on any of the models listed above it is necessary to verify the LAMP OUT CONTROL setting in the Service Mode. The setting of this item will either be Dynamic or Always depending on the model the PCB is installed in. See table 1.

PROCEDURE:

- Enter Service Mode by pressing the following button sequence on the remote control in the stand-by mode: MUTE + 1 + 8 + 2 + POWER. The DLP will power up in the service mode after approximately 25 seconds.
- 2. Select and enter the OPTION menu from the Main SVC Menu.



Select the LAMP OUT CONTROL item.
