Symptom:

Oscillation occurs on the output of Deck "B" and the level meters peak when playing back certain tapes in the Dolby "C" mode. This occurs on tapes

containing a strong signal level (ie. Metal type tapes).

Solution:

The wire for the Headphone output is positioned too close to the tape deck head wire. Reposition the Headphone output wire so that it is away from the head wire (see layout below for details).
