General

This document provides information about the installation of software on the accompanying CD-ROM.

Mount CD-ROM

The CD-ROM on which the software is located uses the PFS format. The steps below assume that the directory `/SD_CDRROM` exists. To mount the CD-ROM, proceed as follows:

1. Create the file `/etc/pfs_fstab` with the following single entry:

```
/dev/dsk/clt2d0 /SD_CDRROM pfs-rrip xlat-unix 0 0
```

where `/dev/dsk/clt2d0` is the special device file for the CD-ROM drive.

2. Run the following commands as root:

```
/usr/sbin/pfs_mountd &
```

```
/usr/sbin/pfsd &
```

```
/usr/sbin/pfs_mount /SD_CDRROM
```

Install Software

Continue the installation procedure by following the steps in the documentation that came with the software, with the following exceptions:

1. When running `swinstall`, click on Source Depot Type and select Local Directory.
2. Type `/SD_CDRROM/DEPOT` in Source Depot Path.

Unmount CD-ROM

After the software is installed, unmount the CD-ROM by running the following command:

```
/usr/sbin/pfs_umount /SD_CDRROM
```
