

# Front Bumper Carrier Bolt Replacement

**Bulletin Classification:** This campaign bulletin addresses a known non-safety-related condition and provides recommended technical diagnosis and repair procedures. Apply this procedure to all vehicles in the affected VIN range listed. These instructions assume knowledge of motor vehicle and high voltage electrical component repairs, and should only be executed by trained professionals. Tesla Motors assumes no liability for injury or property damage due to a failure to properly follow these instructions or repairs attempted by unqualified individuals.

This Service Bulletin supersedes SB-13-10-012 R2, dated 3-Jan-14. Each content change is marked by a vertical line in the left margin. Discard the previous version and replace it with this one.

### Condition

The bolts on the arms of the front bumper carrier might experience corrosion in extreme climates, causing a perceived quality issue. An upgraded set of aluminum bolts is now available.

#### Correction

Replace the shotgun bolts and washers and the headlight bolts with upgraded parts.

## **Procedure**

- 1. Remove the LH and RH underhood aprons (refer to Service Manual procedure 12251202).
- 2. Remove and discard the shotgun bolt and washer and headlight bolt (and washer, if equipped) from the RH arm of the front bumper carrier (Figure 1).

- 3. Inspect the area around the bolt holes for signs of corrosion.
  - If corrosion is present (Figure 2), remove the carrier knob and clean the affected area(s) on the carrier surface and knob threads with a wire brush before continuing this procedure.
  - If corrosion is not present, continue this procedure.



- 4. Replace the shotgun bolt and washer on the RH arm of the front bumper carrier (torque 6 Nm) (Figure 3).
- 5. Replace the headlight bolt on the RH arm of the front bumper carrier (torque 4 Nm) (Figure 3).



- 6. Repeat steps 2–5 on the LH arm of the front bumper carrier.
- 7. Reinstall the components that were removed for access.
- 8. Ensure that the hood is flush to the front LH and RH fenders. Adjust the carrier knobs if necessary.
