Bulletin Classification: This repair bulletin provides instructions and guidelines for a noted condition or a customer concern. The information provided can address a broad range of known or perceived issues with the operation of Tesla vehicles. This bulletin might not be VIN-specific. These instructions assume knowledge of motor vehicle and high voltage electrical component repairs, and should only be executed by trained professionals. Tesla Motors assumes no liability for injury or property damage due to a failure to properly follow these instructions or repairs attempted by unqualified individuals.

This Service Bulletin supersedes SB-14-12-003, dated 15-Sep-14. Each content change is marked by a vertical line in the left margin. Discard the previous version and replace it with this one.

Condition

The aluminum casting on some exterior mirrors might experience corrosion in cold climates, causing white residue to drip onto the door panels, creating a perceived quality issue. Updated mirrors are now available with e-coated frames that prevent corrosion.

Correction

Upon customer complaint, replace both exterior mirrors. Remove residue from the mirror frame and door interior, if necessary.

NOTE: All European power folding mirrors have e-coating and are not susceptible to the corrosion.

NOTE: Do not use these correction codes if a customer with base- or premium-level mirrors has requested an upgrade to power folding mirrors as part of this replacement process. Refer to step 6 and the Billing Information section of this document for more information.

Procedure

- 1. Remove the 2 exterior mirror assemblies (refer to Service Manual procedure 12091102).
- 2. Inspect the interior area of the junction of the door and mirror for residue, as well as the junction of the quarter glass and mirror.

NOTE: The exterior door panels do not need to be inspected at this time. Any residue on them will be removed by the detailer.

3. If there is residue present, perform the following steps:

WARNING: Loctite Aluminum Jelly Cleaner and Brightener can cause damage to skin. Wear appropriate personal protective equipment and apply according to product instructions.

CAUTION: Loctite Aluminum Jelly Cleaner and Brightener can be harmful to certain materials. Limit application to the affected area. Apply according to product instructions.

- a) Wipe the area clean of dust and debris.
- b) If there is residue on the interior of the door, make sure the drain holes at the bottom of the door are unobstructed.



- c) Use Loctite Aluminum Jelly Cleaner and Brightener to clean the area.
- d) Use water to rinse off the cleaner.
- 4. Determine the correct replacement mirrors:

5. Inspect the replacement mirrors to ensure that the aluminum casting has black e-coating (Figure 2).



6. Install the upgraded mirror assemblies (refer to Service Manual procedure 12091102).

NOTE: If a customer with base- or premium-level mirrors has requested an upgrade to power folding mirrors as part of this replacement process, refer to SB-14-12-001, "Power Folding Mirror Installation" for the procedure and correction codes.

NOTE: A harness adaptor might be required depending on the manufacturing date of the vehicle. Refer to Service Manual procedure 12091102 for details.

7. Send the vehicle to the detailer if there is residue on the exposed areas of the doors.

Billing Information

If the customer requested an upgrade to power folding mirrors, enter the following information into Warp Service:

Symptom	Rust / Staining found on door(s) under the exterior mirror(s)	
Concern narrative	In addition to the customer concern about the staining, add a note that the customer requested the upgrade to power-folding mirrors	
Correction narrative	State that there is a "warranty replacement of exterior mirrors and a discount applied to the power-folding mirror upgrade"
