# Panoramic Roof Rattling

Bulletin Classification: This repair bulletin provides instructions and guidelines for a noted condition or a customer concern. The information provided can address a broad range of known or perceived issues with the operation of Tesla vehicles. This bulletin might not be VIN-specific. These instructions assume knowledge of motor vehicle and high voltage electricity repairs, and should only be executed by trained professionals. ### Condition

In some vehicles, the panoramic roof might make a rattling sound when the vehicle is on a rough road and the moving glass is open.

#### Correction

Install a washer on each of the 4 bolts that secure the moving glass to the link assemblies.

## **Procedure**

- Fully open the panoramic moving glass.
- Remove 1 of the bolts that secure the moving glass to the link assemblies (torque 5 Nm) (Figure 1).

Inspect the bolt for a washer (Figure 2).

- If a washer is not present:
  - a) Discard the bolt.



**!** CAUTION: This bolt is one-time use.

- Install a washer onto a new bolt.
- Install the bolt to secure the moving glass to the link assembly (torque 5 Nm).
- d) Repeat steps 1–3 for the remaining 3 bolts that secure the moving glass to the link assemblies. Remove and replace 1 bolt at a time.

- If a washer is present:
  - Remove the washer from the bolt.
  - b) Discard the bolt.



CAUTION: This bolt is one-time use.

- c) Install the washer onto a new bolt.
- d) Install the bolt to secure the moving glass to the link assemblies (torque 5 Nm). No additional work is needed.
