



Replace Glove Box Solenoid

Bulletin Classification: *This repair bulletin provides instructions and guidelines for a noted condition or a customer concern. The information provided can address a broad range of known or perceived issues with the operation of Tesla vehicles. This bulletin might not be VIN-specific. These instructions assume knowledge of motor vehicle and high voltage electrical component repairs, and should only be executed by trained professionals. Tesla assumes no liability for injury or property damage due to a failure to properly follow these instructions or repairs attempted by unqualified individuals.*

Condition

On some Model 3 vehicles, the glove box solenoid might have been lubricated with incorrect grease, and might require excessive force to unlatch the glove box.

Correction

Inspect the vehicle for the symptom related to the condition. If the symptom is present, replace the glove box solenoid with an updated part.

Procedure

1. Attempt to open and close the glove box 5 times:
 - If the glove box unlatches every time during this test, discontinue this procedure.
 - If the glove box remains latched intermittently while attempting to open the glove box, continue to the next step.
2. Remove the glove box (refer to Service Manual procedure 14051002).
3. Inspect the parts label on the glove box:
 - If a round sticker is found with the hand-written date of 5/21, 5/22, or 5/23 (Figure 1), replace the glove box solenoid (refer to Service Manual procedure 14051102).
 - Otherwise, discontinue this procedure and determine why the glove box does not unlatch.

4. Install the glove box (refer to Service Manual procedure 14051002).
