Bulletin Classification: This campaign bulletin addresses a known non-safety-related condition and provides recommended technical diagnosis and repair procedures. Apply this procedure to all vehicles in the affected VIN range listed. These instructions assume knowledge of motor vehicle and high voltage electrical component repairs, and should only be executed by trained professionals. Tesla assumes no liability for injury or property damage due to a failure to properly follow these instructions or repairs attempted by unqualified individuals.

Condition

On some Model X vehicles, the weld on the lower part of the rear air spring module might not meet Tesla's internal specifications.

Correction

Inspect and replace the rear air spring module as determined by the procedure below.

This part number was current at the time of publication. Use the revision listed or later, unless otherwise specified in the Parts Manual.

Procedure

- 1. Remove the rear wheels (refer to Service Manual procedure 34012501).
- 2. Attach the scanner to a laptop.
- 3. Open the excel sheet, located here:
 - a) Navigate to the 2nd tab in the excel spreadsheet. The tab is titled "**Scan here**".
 - b) Select the 1st open cell in column B.
- 4. Scan the QR code located on the rear air spring module (Figure 1). The QR code appears in the cell selected in step 3b.


NOTE: Make sure that the barcode does not have any debris on it.

TIP: It might be necessary to use a mirror to scan the barcode.

5. Type the VIN and LH or RH into the excel spreadsheet.

NOTE: Perform this step on each side of the vehicle.

- If column A displays Reject (Figure 2), skip to step 6.
- If column A displays Accept, reinstall any component that was removed for access and discontinue this
 procedure.





- 6. Remove and replace the rear air spring module (refer to Service Manual procedure 31106002 for LH and 31106102 for RH)
- 7. Follow standard MRB and return instructions for any rejected air spring module.
