# Procedure

- 1. Retrofit the front fog lights:
  - North American vehicles:
    - a. Install new front fog lights (refer to Service Manual procedure 17404002).
    - b. Continue to step 2.
  - Non-North American vehicles:
    - a. Install an updated front fascia harness (refer to Service Manual procedure 17101002).
    - b. Before reinstalling the front fascia on the vehicle, install new front fog lights on the front fascia (refer to Service Manual procedure 17404002).
    - c. Continue to step 2.
- On the vehicle's touchscreen, touch Controls (car icon) > Lights, and then look for the FRONT FOG button (Figure 1).

- If the **FRONT FOG** button is present, touch the button to verify front fog light operation, and then continue to step 14.
- If the **FRONT FOG** button is not present, or if touching the button does not activate front fog lights, continue to step 3.
- 3. Follow the instructions in Toolbox article 55217 to enable the front fog light option code.

**NOTE:** This step is required to ensure the front fog lights are fully enabled. Steps 4—13 will only *temporarily* enable the fog lights so that proper installation and adjustment can be performed. Failure to perform the steps listed in Toolbox article 55217 may result in the vehicle's configuration reverting back and causing a repeat repair.

- 4. Connect a laptop with Toolbox to the vehicle.
- 5. Click the **Dashboards** tab, and then type "info" in the search field.
- 6. Click Infotainment Dashboard from the list on the left side.
- 7. Click Vehicle Configuration from the window on the right side.
- 8. Click **Read Config**, and then click **RUN**.
- 9. Scroll down to "frontFogLamps", and then click Not Installed.
- 10. Select **Installed** from the drop-down menu.
- 11. Click Apply Changes, and then click RUN. The touchscreen will reboot.
- 12. After the touchscreen reboots, touch **Controls** (car icon) > **Lights** and confirm that the **FRONT FOG** button is present, and then touch the button to verify front fog light operation.
- 13. Disconnect the laptop from the vehicle.
- 14. Adjust the front fog lights to specification (refer to Service Manual procedure 17404000).

**NOTE:** When returning the vehicle to the customer, inform them that fog light activation might take a couple business days and that the fog light button might temporarily disappear before the lights are fully activated.
