Condition

Certain Model 3 vehicles were manufactured with charge port carrier assemblies that do not meet Tesla's internal specifications, and the latch actuator within the assembly might seize. If the actuator seizes open, vehicle charging is affected. If the actuator seizes closed, insertion or removal of the charging handle is prevented.

Correction

Replace the charge port carrier assembly with an updated part.
