Bulletin Classification: This repair bulletin provides instructions and guidelines for a noted condition or a customer concern. Condition

Some EMEA Model S, Model X, and Model 3 vehicles were delivered without a Type 2 charging cable.

Correction

Inspect the vehicle for the symptom related to the condition. If the symptom is present, provide a Type 2 charging cable to the customer.

Procedure

Inspect the underhood storage unit and trunk:

- If a Type 2 charging cable (Figure 1) is found in the vehicle, discontinue this procedure and do not provide a new Type 2 charging cable to the customer.
- If a Type 2 charging cable is not found in the vehicle, provide a new Type 2 charging cable to the customer.
