Inspect the vehicle for symptoms related to the condition. If symptoms are present, replace the seat back panels.

NOTE: Some vehicles might have already had one or more of the panels replaced prior to delivery. Make sure to check each panel for the condition, and replace all affected panels.

## **Procedure**

- 1. Open the liftgate and both rear doors.
- 2. Inspect the perimeter of the LH, center, and RH 2<sup>nd</sup> row seat back panels for an excessive gap between the seat back panel and the seat (Figures 1 and 2):

- 3. Replace all affected seat back panels:
  - LH (60) 2<sup>nd</sup> row seat back panel: Refer to Service Manual procedure 13082302.
  - RH (40) 2<sup>nd</sup> row seat back panel: Refer to Service Manual procedure 13082312.
  - Center (20) 2<sup>nd</sup> row seat back panel: Refer to Service Manual procedure 13082322.
- 4. Close the liftgate and both rear doors.
