HARDWARE INSTALLATION

Plug in the AC power adapter into the WNR 2004 AP/Router.




CONNECT THE AP/ROUTER

For cable/DSL users with Static IP addresses, PPoE accounts and/or Advanced Router Configuration you can log into the browser based Configuration Utility at http://192.168.1.1, User Name: UNIDEN, Password: leave blank for configuration.
