Adobe Illustrator

The *TEK_480X.AI* file lets you customize PANTONE Colors for Adobe Illustrator and a Phaser 480X printer. This file is application-specific and printer-specific.

Adobe Illustrator 3.0 and 4.02

- 1. Locate the *TEK_480X.AI* file in the *APPLSPEC* directory either on the Phaser 480X CD-ROM (*UTILS* directory) or on the Windows 3.1 Driver and Printer Utilities diskette.
- 2. Copy the *TEK_480X.AI* file to your computer's hard disk, for example, to Adobe Illustrator's *Color* directory.
- Start the Illustrator program.
- 4. Open the file or image you want to use.
- 5. From the **File** menu, select the **Open** command.
- 6. In the dialog box that appears, locate the directory and file location of the *TEK_480X.AI* file, and open the file.
- When you are working on an image, use the Paint menu and either the Paint Style or Custom Color commands to select PANTONE Colors.

FreeHand 3.0 and 3.1

PageMaker 5.0

The *TEK_480X.ACF* file is used by the application to properly specify PANTONE Colors for Aldus PageMaker and the Phaser 480X printer. This file is application-specific and printer-specific.

- 1. Locate the *TEK_480X.ACF* file in the *APPLSPEC* directory either on the Phaser 480X CD-ROM (*UTILS* directory) or on the Windows 3.1 Driver and Printer Utilities diskette.
- 2. Copy the *TEK_480X.ACF* file to your hard disk.
- 3. Place the file in the USENGLSH\COLOR\ directory in the *Aldus* application directory.
- 4. Start PageMaker.
- 5. Choose **Element**, **Define Colors**, **New**, **Libraries**, then select the Phaser 480X printer.
- 6. Click to select desired PANTONE Color swatches. To add swatches one at a time, hold down the Control key while clicking. To select continuous groups, hold down the Shift key while clicking.
- 7. Click OK in three consecutive dialog boxes.
- 8. The selected colors are available in the **Color Palette** window.

- **9.** In the **Uniform Fill** dialog box, **Custom Palette** should read *TEK_480X.PAL*. Click **OK**.
