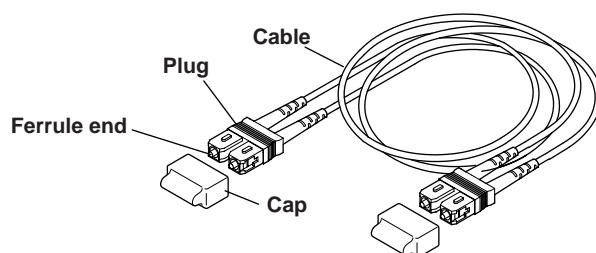


Before Using the Optical Fiber Cable

Make sure to follow the precautions given below when handling the optical fiber cable. YOKOGAWA will not guarantee or be held responsible for damage caused by not following these precautions. For the procedures for connecting/disconnecting the optical fiber cable and the specifications, read the WE7000 User's Manual, IM707001-01E.

Precautions for the Handling Optical Fiber Cable

- Do not bend, pull, or twist the cable excessively.
- When pulling the cable from a wound condition, pull the cable while rotating the bundle.
- When connecting the optical fiber cable, clean the tip of the optical fiber of the plug (ferrule end) thoroughly using gauze immersed in rubbing alcohol. If there is dirt on the ferrule end, connection loss will increase.
- If you are not using the optical fiber cable, cover the ferrule end with the accessory cap to prevent the accumulation of dirt.
- When removing the plug from the port, always pull by the plug, not the cable.
- Do not bend the cable at the base of the plug.
